- uzimajući u obzir mišljenje Europskog gospodarskog i socijalnog odbora od 25. travnja 2012.<sup>1</sup>,
- uzimajući u obzir mišljenje Odbora regija od 3. svibnja 2012.<sup>2</sup>,
- uzimajući u obzir članak 55. Poslovnika,
- uzimajući u obzir izvješće Odbora za regionalni razvoj i mišljenja Odbora za proračunski nadzor, Odbora za okoliš, javno zdravlje i sigurnost hrane, Odbora za industriju, istraživanje i energetiku te Odbora za promet i turizam (A7-0268/2013),

## Amandman 1

### Prijedlog Uredbe Uvodna izjava 1.

*Tekst koji je predložila Komisija*

(1) Člankom 176. Ugovora propisuje se da je namjena Europskog fonda za regionalni razvoj (EFRR) pomoći u ispravljanju glavnih regionalnih nejednakosti u Uniji. EFRR *stoga doprinosi* smanjivanju *razlike* između razina razvijenosti različitih regija i smanjivanju *mjere u kojoj zaostaju regije u najnepovoljnijem položaju, ukљučujući ruralna i urbana područja, industrijska područja u nazadovanju, područja s teškim i stalnim prirodnim i demografskim ograničenjima, kao što su otoci, planinska područja, rijetko naseljena područja i granična područja.*

(1) Člankom 176. Ugovora o *funkcioniranju Europske unije (UFEU)* propisuje se da je namjena Europskog fonda za regionalni razvoj (EFRR) pomoći u ispravljanju glavnih regionalnih nejednakosti u Uniji. *Stoga, u skladu s tim člankom i člankom 174. drugim i trećim stavkom UFEU-a, EFRR treba pridonijeti smanjivanju razlika* između razina razvijenosti različitih regija i smanjivanju *zaostalosti regija* u najnepovoljnijem položaju, *medu kojima posebnu pozornost treba posvetiti područjima koja su izložena teškim i stalnim prirodnim ili demografskim ograničenjima, kao što su najsjevernija područja s vrlo niskom gustoćom naseljenosti te otočne, pogranične i planinske regije.*

## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

After 13 trilogue meetings, 2 technical meetings and few written procedures which followed, the co-legislators have finalised the negotiations on ERDF and reached an agreement

concerning all the articles of the regulation<sup>1</sup>. Four parliamentary committees have contributed with opinions to the work of the Regional Development Committee (REGI): the Committee on Budgets (BUDG), the Committee on the Environment, Public Health and Food Safety (ENVI), the Committee on Industry, Research and Energy (ITRE) and the Committee on Transport and Tourism (TRAN). Moreover, both the European Economic and Social Committee (Rapporteur: Etele Baráth) and the Committee of the Regions (Rapporteur: Michael Schneider) have issued opinions.

The conclusions of the Inter-institutional negotiations were included in the draft report consisting of 74 amendments. Further 21 amendments and 6 compromise amendments<sup>2</sup> were tabled by the Rapporteur in line with the latest outcome of Inter-institutional negotiations. All these amendments were adopted in REGI on the 10th of July and the final Committee report consists of 72 amendments to the Commission's proposal.

This has paved the way for the first reading agreement, as on the 26th of June the Permanent Representatives Committee (Coreper) of the Council adopted the Council's final position and the outgoing Irish Presidency informed the European Parliament that the latest text outlined in the fourth column table document could constitute a basis for a compromise between the two institutions.

The Commission proposal for the 2014-2020 ERDF regulation brought a novelty by introducing a thematic concentration and by strengthening the urban dimension. The proposed thematic concentration meant focusing on a limited number of thematic objectives, further detailed in investment priorities. The mechanism set up obligatory quotas for investment under pre-defined thematic objectives that vary depending on the category of region. This mechanism aimed at contributing to achievement of the Europe 2020 Strategy objectives. The strengthened urban dimension included three elements: an obligatory delegation of 5% of the ERDF resources for management to cities, an Urban Development Platform and support for innovative actions in the field of sustainable urban development. Most of these provisions were maintained by the co-legislators, however, they were slightly modified during the negotiations. This improvement shall provide for flexibility and allow for better adaptation of the ERDF support to various needs of regions across the whole EU.

The EP Negotiating Team defended its mandate during the negotiations and as a result, the vast majority of amendments improving the distribution of ERDF support in the next programming period are included in the Inter-institutional agreement. As far as the scope of support is concerned, the EP managed to broaden it by introducing the eligibility of small scale cultural and sustainable tourism infrastructure and by allowing for support for productive investment also in large enterprises (in the areas of research and innovation, shift towards low carbon economy and ICT provided that there is cooperation with SMEs). Moreover, the Parliament removed the ban for investments in infrastructure providing basic services in the areas of environment, transport and ICT in more developed regions. Finally, it narrowed the scope of support for the airport infrastructure by reducing it only to investments related to environmental protection.

The agreed compromise package concerning the thematic concentration includes several provisions from the EP mandate which called for more flexibility in this respect. The most important is the inclusion of an additional thematic objective in the obligatory ones and the introduction of a separate mechanism for the concentration for the category of transition regions. Also, a set of Parliament's derogations was included in the package, in particular concerning specific needs of regions designated with the phasing-out status in the 2007-2013 period and NUTS 2 level regions consisting solely of islands, so as the derogation for the northern sparsely populated regions. An important provision stemming from the EP mandate about the derogation for productive investments in enterprises in outermost regions, irrespectively of their size, is also included in the agreed compromise.

The Parliament's negotiators introduced several new elements to the list of investment priorities from its mandate that enlarged the scope of future investments. The addition of "eco-innovation" to the thematic objective on strengthening research, technological development and innovation and the addition of "promoting social inclusion through improved access to social, cultural and recreational services" in order to contribute to social inclusion and combating poverty and any discrimination, occurred to be the most controversial during the negotiations. High-efficiency co-generation of heat and power, e-culture, energy efficiency measures in large enterprises, rehabilitation of railway systems and broad eligibility for improvement of urban environment and revitalisation of cities are some of the further additional investment priorities added by the Parliament. Moreover, the investment priority in relation to urban mobility was moved to the thematic objective 4: shift towards low-carbon economy included in the obligatory ring-fencing.

A common approach with mainstream programmes concerning indicators was agreed in order to better capture the outputs of and increase in the overall orientation on results. The Parliament agreed to follow the Council Partial General Approach concerning the list of indicators figuring in the Annex to the regulation, as this list of indicators results from extensive consultations between the Member States' experts and the Commission. Nevertheless, the provision of a delegated act to amend the list of indicators in order to ensure effective assessment of progress in programme implementation has been introduced.

The outcome of the negotiations on the provisions related to the urban dimension can be considered as the biggest success for the EP NT. The compromise text on integrated sustainable urban development is based to a large extend on the EP mandate including the most controversial provision about the delegation of powers to Urban Authorities and the focus on functional areas.

From the very beginning the European Parliament welcomed the Commission proposal to strengthen the urban dimension of cohesion policy. The EP supported the "ring-fencing" of 5% of the national ERDF allocation for cities where integrated actions for sustainable urban development are implemented, thus the main element of the new policy. However, from the very beginning the house questioned the proposed "list of cities" to be drawn by each Member State for this purpose, and this provision was deleted by the European Parliament quite early in the parliamentary process, which was confirmed in the trilogues.

The negotiations resulted in a change of provisions concerning the possible methods for the implementation of the integrated actions for sustainable urban development along the EP

mandate. The co-legislators agreed that they can be undertaken not only through Integrated Territorial Investments but also through a specific operational programme or a specific priority axis. The provision concerning the level of delegation assured needed flexibility by defining a whole spectrum of possible delegation which needs to be decided between the managing authorities and the urban authorities: from a simple selection of operations to a full delegation in the form of a global grant.

Furthermore, from the beginning, the Parliament opposed the Urban Development Platform and its original mandate included a deletion of this provision. However, after long discussions, the EP agreed to create an Urban Development Network instead, with a limited scope of actions, which will aim only at exchange of experience related to the implementation of 5% of the ERDF resources for integrated actions for sustainable urban development and the innovative actions. This will allow for the evaluation of the new elements by the Commission but will assure the complementary to existing programmes and bodies at the same time.

The text as agreed provides a clearer and simplified framework for investment, as it ensures a better coordination with other fund specific regulations, as well as with the CPR, through the linkages with and through the thematic objectives and/or the investment priorities. This is a major breakthrough in terms of improved coordination and stronger synergies of and among the funds and their implementation in view of delivering smart, sustainable and inclusive growth in line with the Europe 2020 Strategy. The new element of thematic concentration provides for a greater concentration of resources on a limited number of objectives that should result in a better added value of the interventions. Finally, the new ERDF provides for the first time for an obligatory urban dimension and assures for a stronger focus on urban development at a strategic level.

### **Declarations agreed during Interinstitutional negotiations**

Apart from the legal provisions finalised during Interinstitutional negotiations, two of the most difficult agreements in the ERDF Regulation were adopted together with accompanying declarations.

Agreement on the text on indicators for the Investment Growth and Jobs Goal was accompanied by the following "Joint declaration of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning the application of Article 6 of the ERDF Regulation, Article 15 of the ETC Regulation and Article 4 of the Cohesion Fund Regulation":

"The European Parliament and the Council note the assurance provided by the Commission to the EU legislature that the common output indicators for the ERDF Regulation, the ETC Regulation and the Cohesion Fund Regulation to be included in an annex to, respectively, each regulation, are the outcome of a lengthy preparatory process involving the evaluation experts of both the Commission and the Member States and, in principle, are expected to remain stable."

The Parliament's amendment to Article 11(2) concerning **exemption of** the operating aid for outermost regions from the notification obligation for the state aid has been dealt with in Recital 11 and in the following "Declaration of the Commission":

"The Commission shares the objective expressed by the European Parliament of simplifying

state aid procedures as regards operating aid granted to undertakings established in the outermost regions which are linked to the offsetting of the additional costs incurred in such regions as a result of their specific economic and social situation.

According to the proposal for the future General Block Exemption Regulation (GBER) as recently published by the Commission services<sup>1</sup>, operating aid intended to compensate certain additional costs incurred by beneficiaries established in these regions<sup>2</sup> would be considered compatible with the internal market, under the conditions stipulated therein, and would thus be exempted from notification under Article 108(3) TFEU. The Commission considers that this will provide a sound basis for achieving the simplification which is sought, and will take full account of all observations received from Member States in the on-going consultation process in view of the adoption of the Regulation in 2014."

### **SHORT JUSTIFICATION**

The cohesion policy is one of the main tools of investment to support key priorities of the Union laid down in the Europe 2020 strategy. Under Articles 174 and 176 of the TFEU, the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) is intended to reduce the gap between the development levels of regions and the delay suffered by the less-favoured regions, so its actions must be directed in particular to the countries and regions where the needs are greatest.

According to the European Commission's proposal, the 2014-2020 ERDF would support regional and local development by co-financing investments in R&D and innovation; climate change and environment; business support to SMEs; services of common economic interest; telecommunication, energy and transport infrastructures; health, education and social infrastructures; and sustainable urban development. Your Rapporteur believes however that activities linked both to tourism and cultural heritage should be better reflected in the regulation.

To ensure greater concentration of ERDF support on EU priorities, as laid down by the EU 2020 strategy, the European Commission proposes a thematic concentration while taking into account the different level of development. The Rapporteur supports the need to avoid duplication of effort, as well as the effects of dispersion and insufficient prioritization that in the past, have limited the added value of European investment. Especially at a time of scarce resources, thematic concentration and the identification of investment priorities, in line with the objectives of the strategy Europe 2020 is essential.

The proposed Regulation also provides for an increased focus on sustainable urban development notably through the earmarking of a minimum of 5% of ERDF resources for

sustainable urban development. Your Rapporteur welcomes this increased focus.

The financial envelope for the ERDF for 2014-2020 is not mentioned in the ERDF proposed regulation but in the proposed regulation laying down common provisions for all funds [CPR].<sup>1</sup> Article 84(1) of the later foresees 96,52% of the global envelope of structural and cohesion funds, i.e. 324,3 billion (2011 constant prices), for the Investment for growth and jobs goal. Out of these 324,3 billion , 68,7 billion (2011 constant prices) are allocated for the Cohesion Fund. Furthermore, the Commission proposes minimum shares for the European Social Fund (ESF) for each category of regions, implying a minimum overall share for the ESF of 25% of the budget allocated to structural and cohesion funds altogether, i.e. EUR 84 billion. As a consequence, a maximum of EUR 183,3 billion remains available for the ERDF for the period 2014-2020. This represents a decrease compared to the 2007-2013 period. Your Rapporteur regrets that the global envelope for cohesion policy is decreased and that, as a consequence, the ERDF budgetary allocation is decreased.

It will however depend on the final outcome of the negotiations on the whole envelope to be allocated to cohesion policy. It cannot be fixed until agreement is reached on the proposal for a regulation laying down the Multiannual Financial Framework for the years 2014-2020. Furthermore, your Rapporteur wishes to underline the conviction expressed by the European Parliament in its resolution of 8 June 2011 that "at least a 5% increase of resources is needed for the next MFF" compared to the 2013 level and that "the amounts allocated to cohesion policy in the current financial programming period should be at least maintained in the next period" which is apparently not the case.

Concerning other provisions with budgetary implications, your Rapporteur welcomes the Commission's simplification efforts in the Common Provision Regulation<sup>2</sup>. Your Rapporteur further stresses the responsibility of the Member States to support these simplification efforts.

## **OPINION OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE ENVIRONMENT, PUBLIC HEALTH AND FOOD SAFETY**

### **SHORT JUSTIFICATION**

Cohesion policy is the main investment instrument for supporting the key priorities of the Union as enshrined in the Europe 2020 strategy. Since environmental protection and sustainable development are central to those priorities, the EU's cohesion policy is also the most suitable way to support the shift towards a competitive and low-carbon economy and the investment in climate change mitigation and adaption measures, as well as environmental and biodiversity protection and sustainable urban development.

The Commission has presented a number of legislative proposals for the new cohesion policy framework. The current proposal is an integral part of that framework, and introduces changes aimed at improving the policy's impact in terms of achieving the EU priorities. The legislative package sets out a list of thematic objectives in line with the Europe 2020 strategy and lays down a series of provisions common to all the Structural Funds and intended to simplify management procedures and enhance efficiency.

The proposal sets out specific provisions for the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF), whose purpose is to correct imbalances between EU regions. For each thematic objective, the proposal sets out a list of investment priorities to which the ERDF may contribute, and in particular, establishes the following *thematic concentration*:

- in more developed regions and regions in transition, where GDP is equal to or higher than 75% of the European average, at least 80% of resources are allocated to energy efficiency and renewables, research and innovation and SME support, (with at least 20% being allocated to energy efficiency and renewables);
- in less developed regions, where GDP is less than 75% of the European average, in order to

take the greatest variety of development needs into account, those percentages have been reduced to 50% and 6% respectively.

Furthermore, 5% of ERDF resources are allocated to sustainable urban development.

The proposal for a regulation also seeks to place greater emphasis on results by defining common indicators relating to physical outputs and progress towards the objectives to be achieved.

The rapporteur agrees with and supports the Commission proposal, while at the same time tabling a number of amendments seeking to make ERDF investments more effective in achieving EU environmental priorities.

First of all, while the Commission's decision to establish a system of thematic concentration for the ERDF is to be fully supported, allocating 6% of the resources for less developed regions to funding the shift to a low-carbon economy in all sectors is insufficient, given that it is precisely these regions that require a substantial investment in order to reduce emissions. An increase to 15% is therefore being proposed.

At the same time, environmental protection and support for resource efficiency should not be excluded from the thematic concentration system. In particular, protecting and restoring biodiversity and promoting ecosystem services are key challenges that must be addressed in order to safeguard the future of the environment, and, together with measures to tackle climate change, should be the underlying focus of all sustainable development policies. It should be pointed out that, although biodiversity is of fundamental importance to the quality of human life, as well as the survival of species, the 2010 biodiversity protection targets have not been met. For these reasons, a number of amendments have been tabled in order to include the thematic objective of protecting the environment and promoting resource efficiency among the ERDF priorities, in accordance with the thematic concentration system (80% of resources for more developed regions and regions in transition and 50% for less developed regions).

Finally, particular attention is paid to common indicators for the ERDF, which need to be clearly defined to enable the results achieved in respect of the environmental priorities to be accurately measured. Firstly, in connection with the prevention and management of climate change-related risks the indicators should not focus solely on civil protection measures; greater attention should be paid to increasing the prevention and resistance capacity of ecosystems. Specific nature and biodiversity indicators should also be introduced, to cover, for example, the conservation of marine and coastal habitats, the development of green infrastructure and the creation of new green urban spaces.

## **OPINION OF THE COMMITTEE ON INDUSTRY, RESEARCH AND ENERGY**

for the Committee on Regional Development

on the proposal for a regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on specific provisions concerning the European Regional Development Fund and the Investment for growth and jobs goal and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1080/2006  
(COM(2011)0614 – C7–0328/2011 – 2011/0275(COD))

### **SHORT JUSTIFICATION**

The Structural Funds is one of the essential EU instruments for realising the agreed EU policy objectives in the field of energy, innovation, research, telecom and SME by way of strategic financial investments. Our Committee is therefore deeply interested and involved in the right setting of the objectives and investment priorities of the EU Cohesion Policy 2014–2020. Furthermore we have to guarantee that the investments through the Structural Funds are adequately coordinated with other Community programmes, in particular Horizon 2020, the CEF and COSME and that synergies between the different Funds are exploited at the best.

In order to fine tune the objectives and investment priorities and to improve the coordination and proper implementation of the fund, your rapporteur propose therefore several amendments.

Your rapporteur welcomes the Commission's focus on research and innovation, information technologies, small and medium-sized enterprises and energy, but takes the view that an appropriate degree of flexibility should be used as far as the regions are concerned, in order to promote and strengthen integrated development policies geared towards growth and the achievement of excellence in all sectors. She therefore believes that any changes to the percentages listed in Article 4 call for further debate within the ITRE committee and that the thematic concentration objectives should be examined as part of a full revision of the legislation in question.

## **OPINION OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORT AND TOURISM**

### **SHORT JUSTIFICATION**

#### ***Commission's proposal***

This regulation establishes the provisions governing the European Regional Development Fund and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1083/2006. The ERDF aims at strengthening economic and social cohesion in the EU by correcting imbalances between its regions. It supports regional and local development by co-financing investments in R&D and innovation, climate change and environment, business support to SMEs, services of common economic interest, telecommunication, energy and transport infrastructures, health, education and social infrastructures and sustainable urban development.

#### ***Rapporteur's point of view***

The rapporteur supports the Commission's proposal but advocates for a better integration of the EU 2020 targets into the EU's structural instruments, in particular when it comes to funding priorities. Furthermore, coherence between this regulation and those on the Transeuropean Transport Networks (TEN-T) and the Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) is indispensable.

He endorses a result-oriented approach and supports the increased use of (ex ante-) conditionality when it comes to a shift towards more sustainable and efficient transport and mobility as well as to safety, noise reduction, environmental legislation and the protection of the climate and biodiversity.

The transport sector is responsible for approximately 24% of all CO2 emissions and has seen them increase by 34% since 1990. Given the time needed to design and deliver large-scale infrastructure projects, investments made over the next years will determine transport and mobility over the next decades. In order to ensure the quality standard of living for the next

generations of the EU citizens, European projects should support sustainable modes, focusing on mobility chains that combine walking, cycling, car sharing, car pooling and public transport and are flexible enough to accommodate new mobility solutions.

As the Cohesion Fund and the ERDF are a major source of EU transport funding it is crucial to shift the EU's funding priorities within their respective frameworks and to focus on investments in smart and sustainable mobility in order to avoid, or at least limit, any related external costs in the future. This will also reduce the burden on future public budgets at the level of regions, Member States and the EU. Europe can no longer afford to support extremely costly and lengthy large-scale projects. Instead of "thinking big" the EU start to "act smart".

In this respect, the European added value is decisive and it is the rapporteur's view that the focus of structural support should be put on reinforcing intermodality and removing bottlenecks, filling-in missing trans-border links as well as ensuring that legislation related to safety and the protection of the environment, the climate and biodiversity is fully respected. To this end there is a need for better environmental impact assessments and clear ex ante criteria in order to incentivise the beneficiaries and make them rethink their policies at national, regional and local level.

This point of view is reflected by the following amendments.
