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## **DRAFT EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION**

**on the draft Council decision repealing Decision 2007/124/EC, Euratom establishing for the period 2007 to 2013, as part of General Programme on Security and Safeguarding Liberties, the Specific Programme 'Prevention, Preparedness and Consequence Management of Terrorism and other Security related risks' (15187/2013 – C7-0418/2013 – 2013/0281(APP))**

**(Special legislative procedure – consent)**

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the draft Council decision (15178/2013),
  - having regard to the request for consent submitted by the Council in accordance with Article 352 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union and Article 203 of the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community (C7-0418/2013),
  - having regard to Rules 81(1) and 46(1) of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to the recommendation of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs (A7-0432/2013),
1. Consents to the draft Council decision;
  2. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.

## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The current Specific Programme "Prevention, Preparedness and Consequence Management of Terrorism and other Security-related risks" (the CIPS specific programme) has been established for the period 2007-2013.

It aims at preventing, preparing for and protecting people and critical infrastructure against terrorist attacks and other security-related incidents.

This programme will be replaced by the Internal Security Funds (ISF-police) for the period 2014-2020.

Given the fact that the CIPS specific programme has been adopted under a double legal base (EC/Euratom), a separate legal act is required to repeal it.
