Article 25a

Data Protection impact assessment

1. Europol shall carry out an assessment of the impact of any new envisaged personal data processing systems and procedures on the protection of personal data and notify it to the European Data Protection Supervisor.

2. The assessment shall contain a general description of the envisaged processing operations, an assessment of the risks to the rights and freedoms of data subjects, the measures envisaged to address those risks, safeguards, security measures and mechanisms to ensure the protection of personal data and their compliance with the provisions in this Regulation, taking into account the rights and legitimate interests of the data subjects.
