Proposal for a regulation**Recital 1***Text proposed by the Commission**Amendment*

(1) *On 25 and 26 June 2015,¹² the European Council called for wider efforts in resolving the migrant crisis in a comprehensive manner, including through the reinforcement of the management of borders to better manage growing mixed migratory flows. Furthermore, on 23 September 2015,¹³ the European Council stressed the need to tackle the dramatic situation at the external borders as well as to strengthen the controls at those borders, notably through additional resources for the European Agency for the Management of Operational Cooperation at the External Borders of the Member States of the European Union, the European Asylum Support Office and Europol, with human resources and technical contributions from Member States.*

(1) *The Union's common immigration and asylum policy, including the Schengen system, has proven to be a failure, resulting in even more uncontrolled immigration.*
