**Proposal for a directive****Recital 9***Text proposed by the Commission*

(9) Some semi-automatic firearms can **be** easily converted to automatic firearms, thus posing a threat to security. Even in the absence of conversion **to category "A"**, certain semi-automatic firearms may be very dangerous when their capacity regarding the number of rounds is high. **Such semi-automatic weapons should therefore be banned for civilian use.**

*Amendment*

(9) Some semi-automatic firearms can easily **be** converted to automatic firearms, thus posing a threat to security. Even in the absence of **such** conversion, certain semi-automatic firearms may be very dangerous when their capacity regarding the number of rounds is high. **The mere possibility of fitting a loading device with the capacity over 32 rounds does not determine the categorisation of the firearm.**

**Proposal for a directive****Recital 13 a (new)***Text proposed by the Commission**Amendment*

*(13a) Where Member States have national laws addressing antiques or reproduction of front loading models, these weapons are not subject to the requirements of the Directive. Other items, such as airsoft devices, paintball devices, fall outside of the definition of a firearm and are not regulated elsewhere in the Directive, so the provisions of this Directive are not applicable.*
