Amendment

21a. Calls on the Council and the Commission to refrain from starting any negotiations with the Arab Republic of Egypt until the impact assessment referred to in paragraphs 1 and 4 demonstrates: (a) the necessity and proportionality of an international agreement with that country; (b) that the level of data protection resulting from these agreements is essentially equivalent to the level of protection provided by EU law, in particular with regard to the purpose limitation principle, the right of access, the right to rectification, and control by an independent authority; (c) that the Arab Republic of Egypt provides for adequate safeguards as regards the protection of fundamental rights and freedoms protected by the Charter, particularly freedom of expression, freedom of religion and human dignity;
