Use of small extracts from pre-existing works

- 1. Member States shall provide for an exception to the rights provided for in Articles 2 and 3 of Directive 2001/29/EC, point (a) of Article 5 and Article 7(1) of Directive 96/9/EC, point (a) of Article 4(1) of Directive 2009/24/EC and Article 11 of this Directive in order to allow for the use of extracts from pre-existing works and other subject-matter in content uploaded or made available by users, other than in the course of their work, for purposes such as criticism, review, illustration, caricature, parody or pastiche, provided that the extracts: (a) relate to works or other subject-matter that have been lawfully made available to the public; (b) are accompanied by an attribution whenever possible; and (c) are used in a manner that does not conflict with the normal exploitation of the works.
- 2. Any contractual provision contrary to the exception provided for in this Article shall be unenforceable.
