## DRAFT EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

**on the Council position at first reading with a view to the adoption of a regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund for Displaced Workers (EGF) and repealing Regulation (EU) No 1309/2013 (05532/1/2021 – C9-0139/2021 – 2018/0202(COD))**

**(Ordinary legislative procedure: second reading)**

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the Council position at first reading (05532/1/2021 – C9-0139/2021),
  - having regard to the reasoned opinion submitted, within the framework of Protocol No 2 on the application of the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality, by the Swedish Parliament, asserting that the draft legislative act does not comply with the principle of subsidiarity,
  - having regard to the opinion of the European Economic and Social Committee of 12 December 2018<sup>1</sup>,
  - having regard to the opinion of the Committee of the Regions of 5 December 2018<sup>2</sup>,
  - having regard to the opinion of the Commission (COM(2021)0196),
  - having regard to its position at first reading<sup>3</sup> on the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2018)0380),
  - having regard to Article 294(7) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
  - having regard to the provisional agreement approved by the committee responsible under Rule 74(4) of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to Rule 67 of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to the recommendation for second reading of the Committee on Employment and Social Affairs (A9-0140/2021),
1. Approves the Council position at first reading;
  2. Notes that the act is adopted in accordance with the Council position;
  3. Instructs its President to sign the act with the President of the Council, in accordance with Article 297(1) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union;
  4. Instructs its Secretary-General to sign the act, once it has been verified that all the

procedures have been duly completed, and, in agreement with the Secretary-General of the Council, to arrange for its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*;

5. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.
