4. ***Insists*** that new policy priorities or tasks must be accompanied by ***fresh*** resources, ***and that creating an agency or expanding its mandate should not come at the expense of existing programmes or agencies; compensates, therefore, reductions*** in appropriations ***for funding programmes proposed by the Commission*** to reinforce the financial envelopes of decentralised agencies; underlines the fact that proper coordination and synergies between agencies are needed to increase the effectiveness of their work, especially where there is convergence towards specific policy objectives, in order to allow for the fair and efficient use of public money;

4. ***Stresses*** that new policy priorities or tasks must be accompanied by ***an efficient use of available*** resources; ***regrets the increase*** in appropriations to reinforce the financial envelopes of decentralised agencies, ***since it questions if their policy priorities or tasks could not be better accomplished by existing Directorates-General of the Commission or by Member States in order to prevent duplication of roles and costs and also improving transparency***; underlines ***however*** the fact that proper coordination and synergies between agencies are needed to increase the effectiveness of their work, especially where there is convergence towards specific policy objectives, in order to allow for the fair and efficient use of public money;
