4. *Insists* that new policy priorities or tasks must be accompanied by fresh resources, and that creating an agency or expanding its mandate should not come at the expense of existing programmes or agencies; compensates, therefore, reductions in appropriations for funding programmes proposed by the Commission to reinforce the financial envelopes of decentralised agencies; underlines the fact that proper coordination and synergies between agencies are needed to increase the effectiveness of their work, especially where there is convergence towards specific policy objectives, in order to allow for the fair and efficient use of public money;

4. **Stresses** that new policy priorities or tasks must be accompanied by an efficient use of available resources; regrets the increase in appropriations to reinforce the financial envelopes of decentralised agencies, since it questions if their policy priorities or tasks could not be better accomplished by existing Directorates-General of the Commission or by Member States in order to prevent duplication of roles and costs and also improving transparency; underlines however the fact that proper coordination and synergies between agencies are needed to increase the effectiveness of their work, especially where there is convergence towards specific policy objectives, in order to allow for the fair and efficient use of public money;
