## DRAFT EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

**on the proposal for a regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council repealing Regulation (EEC) No 1108/70 of the Council introducing an accounting system for expenditure on infrastructure in respect of transport by rail, road and inland waterway, and Commission Regulation (EC) No 851/2006 specifying the items to be included under the various headings in the forms of accounts shown in Annex I to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1108/70 (COM(2022)0381 – C9-0294/2022 – 2022/0232(COD))**

**(Ordinary legislative procedure: first reading)**

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2022)0381),
  - having regard to Article 294(2) and Article 91 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, pursuant to which the Commission submitted the proposal to Parliament (C9-0294/2022),
  - having regard to Article 294(3) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
  - having regard to the opinion of the European Economic and Social Committee<sup>1</sup>,
  - after having consulted the Committee of the Regions,
  - having regard to Rule 59 of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to the report of the Committee on Transport and Tourism (A9-0286/2022),
1. Adopts its position at first reading, taking over the Commission proposal;
  2. Calls on the Commission to refer the matter to Parliament again if it replaces, substantially amends or intends to substantially amend its proposal;
  3. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Regulation (EEC) No 1108/70 (legal basis Article 91 TFEU) requires to collect infrastructure expenditure data for rail, road and inland waterways, as well as statistics about the use of the corresponding infrastructure, first of all to collect information on transport infrastructure expenditure and transport infrastructure use ('returns') in the Member States.

The Regulation has been amended many times, nevertheless, it partly overlaps with more recent data collection rules in force, e.g.:

- data collection under the TEN-T Regulation (Regulation (EU)) No 1315/2013 collecting a substantial amount of technical and financial information on the TEN-T core and comprehensive networks;
- the Rail Market Monitoring Survey, based on Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/110016, collecting information on railways in Europe, including on rail infrastructure expenditure for maintenance, renewals, upgrades and new infrastructure;
- Eurostat collecting various statistics on road freight transport, rail transport and inland waterways transport.

In accordance to the Regulation (EEC) No 1108/70 every year the Commission should submit a summary report with the main statistics about transport infrastructure expenditure and use. The Commission has not prepared new reports since 1998, mainly because it had hardly received any data from Member States or the data it had received was mostly incomplete.

The definitions and classifications used in the Regulation have become obsolete, many concepts and classifications are outdated or incompatible with the current classifications.

In conclusion, the Regulation (EEC) No 1108/70 has become obsolete and the data that would have been collected under the Regulation have either become available from other sources or are no longer needed in the form and specifications required under the Regulation. Commission Regulation (EC) No 851/2006 specifying the items to be included under the various headings in the forms of accounts shown in Annex I to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1108/70. Therefore, the Commission Regulation (EC) No 851/2006 has become obsolete too.
