Proposal for a regulation**Article 26 – paragraph 2***Text proposed by the Commission**Amendment*

2. The final distributor making available on the market within the territory of a Member State in sales packaging cold or hot beverages filled into a container at the point of sale for take-away shall ensure that: **deleted**

(a) from 1 January 2030, 20 % of those beverages are made available in reusable packaging within a system for re-use or by enabling refill;

(b) from 1 January 2040, 80 % of those beverages are made available in reusable packaging within a system for re-use or by enabling refill.

Justification

This amendment aims to delete paragraph two of the provisional trilogue agreement, setting 100% re-use targets for a wide range of B2B transport and sales packaging formats when transporting goods between a company's or partner company's different sites: 2. By way of derogation from paragraph 1, the economic operators using transport packaging or sales packaging used for transporting products within the territory of the European Union between different sites on which the operator performs its activity; or between any of the sites on which the operator performs its activity and the sites of any other linked enterprise or partner

enterprise, as defined in Article 3 of the Annex to Commission Recommendation 2003/361, in the version publicly available on [OP: Please insert the date = the date of entry into force of this Regulation], shall ensure that such packaging is reusable within a system for re-use.

3. A final distributor that is *deleted* conducting its business activity in the HORECA sector and that is making available on the market within the territory of a Member State in sales packaging take-away ready-prepared food, intended for immediate consumption without the need of any further preparation, and typically consumed from the receptacle, shall ensure that:

(a) from 1 January 2030, 10 % of those products are made available in reusable packaging within a system for re-use or by enabling refill;

(b) from 1 January 2040, 40 % of those products are made available in reusable packaging within a system for re-use or by enabling refill.

Justification

This amendment aims to delete paragraph three of the provisional trilogue agreement, setting 100% re-use targets for a wide range of B2B transport and sales packaging formats when

transporting goods between companies within the same Member State:

3. By way of derogation from paragraph 1, the economic operators using transport packaging or sales packaging used for transportation to delivering products to another economic operator within the same Member State shall ensure that such packaging is reusable within a system for re-use.
