Motion for a resolution**Paragraph 24***Motion for a resolution*

24. In this context, calls on the Commission to propose tangible solutions that will allow consumers, in particular citizens living in cross-border regions or belonging to linguistic minorities, legal access to varying cross-catalogue content across borders; recalls the obligation for the Commission to report on the evaluation of the Geo-blocking Regulation, and recommends accompanying it with a comprehensive revision of the Geo-blocking Regulation by 2025 the latest, with a particular focus on the inclusion of audiovisual services in the scope of the Regulation; while ***acknowledging the need for further assessment of the potential impact on the overall dynamics of the audiovisual sector ensuring sustainable business models for economic operators***; recommends that owing to its complexity as a result of factors such as the diversity of content, providers, business models, consumers' preferences, licensing models and complex value chains, the Commission should consider a gradual approach, targeting specific type and distribution models of the audiovisual sector one-by-one, and gather additional evidence before further steps are taken; while assuring realistic timeframes for any potential changes that will allow providers of audiovisual services to adapt their business models properly to the new rules and
