Recalls the importance of health policies and the clear political commitment in the 2020 MFF agreement to prioritise health funding **in light of the COVID-19 pandemic**; is, therefore, very disappointed by the cut of EUR 1 billion to EU4Health, **which represents more than a third of the programme's funds for 2025-2027**; considers that such a decision **will** undermine preparedness for any further pandemic and **health crisis and** curtail the Union's ability to support public health systems **that are already suffering from cuts**; points out, however, that, at Parliament's request, the spending profile of the programme has been adapted in order to mitigate the impact of the cut on practical implementation by spreading the effect of the reduction more evenly across the remaining years;
