7. To organise a High Level Conference to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights on 29 November 2023 in the premises of the European Parliament, in Brussels.

8. To organise regularly meetings with Brussels-based human rights organisations in the appropriate format.

9. To organise an exchange of views with the EEAS on the midterm review of the EU Action Plan on Human Rights and Democracy 2020-2024 during its meeting of 22/23 May 2023.

10. To organise a joint meeting with ENVI-DROI-DARP for the COP28 to take place in the United Arab Emirates.

11. To reflect on the response to be given to El Salvador’s decision to deny access to DROI mission which was scheduled in May 2023.

- Decision to endorse the decisions taken by the DROI Coordinators except for decisions under points 1 and 6.
- Decision to ask DROI to shorten their key messages to the Commission Work programme 2023.
- Decision to request an AFET opinion under item 6 on Establishing a framework for ensuring a secure and sustainable supply of critical raw materials (2023/0079(COD)) and attribute it to the EPP (cf. item II.A.2a).

Subject: ING2 draft report on recommendations for reform of European Parliament's rules on transparency, integrity, accountability and anti-corruption

Dear Chair,

The European Parliament's decision of 14 February 2023 updating the ING2 mandate foresees a close cooperation with the Committee on Constitutional Affairs and the Committee on Foreign Affairs.

Following this decision, the Coordinators of the Committee on Foreign Affairs decided at their meeting on 28 February 2023 to submit a written contribution within the framework of the report of ING2 on recommendations for a reform of European Parliament's rules on transparency, integrity, accountability and anti-corruption.

The Committee on Foreign Affairs has been following the work INGE and ING2 have been carrying out since September 2020. Your committees' work has provided valuable input to the debate on foreign interference and helped raising the European Parliament's profile in this important matter. The Committee on Foreign Affairs, as the committee responsible for the strengthening of political relations with third countries, will build on these findings in the future and will integrate them in its positions and communication towards these countries.

The Committee on Foreign Affairs also welcomes the draft report on recommendations for reform of European Parliament's rules on transparency, integrity, accountability and anti-corruption.

The Committee on Foreign Affairs calls on the *Special Committee on foreign interference in all democratic processes in the European Union, including disinformation, and the strengthening of integrity, transparency and accountability in the European Parliament* to incorporate the following suggestions into its motion for a resolution:

[in the part 'Reinforcing the security culture within Parliament....']

Calls for Parliament's services to put in place effective monitoring and surveillance systems to detect foreign interference while ensuring the respect of the free mandate, and to offer to both MEPs and staff the opportunity to have electronic devices scanned for malicious surveillance tools;

[in the part 'relations with non-EU countries and entities']

Denounces in the strongest terms Qatar's and Morocco's alleged attempts to influence Parliament's Members, former Members and staff through acts of corruption, thereby subverting the EU's democratic process through malign interference;

Believes that foreign interference or the attempt thereof must not remain without consequences for the country concerned; intends to suspend any legislative or non-legislative proposal on cooperation with state authorities of such a country for a period commensurate to the severity of the interference; intends in the framework of the annual budgetary procedure to suspend all funding from Union programmes to state authorities in such a country while preserving funding for civil society organisations and independent media as well as humanitarian assistance;

Believes that the Committee on Foreign Affairs should request the Ambassador to the EU of such a country to appear in the Committee on Foreign Affairs for an exchange of views;

Underlines that parliamentary diplomacy is a fundamental activity of the European Parliament and that the Parliament should uphold a minimum level of diplomatic relations even in the most conflictual contexts; stresses, however, that parliamentary diplomacy should be appropriately framed and subject to transparency measures;

Notes that the Conference of Presidents, in view of recent developments concerning certain third countries, held an exchange of views with the aim of establishing clear guidance to Members of the European Parliament and its staff in terms of interactions with representatives of these countries and their access to European Parliament premises;

Welcomes the adoption on 13 April 2023 by the Conference of Presidents of Guidelines on relations with representatives of certain third countries, which in some cases restrict official contacts;

Considers in this regard that it is of utmost importance to ensure the implementation of the transparency measures laid down in these guidelines, notably by keeping records of any contacts with third country representatives;

Calls however for more general declarations in cases where the naming of individuals or organisations could put their life or safety at risk;

Believes that election observation missions should put additional focus on actual or attempted interference before the election day, in particular online/on social media; [to be added to paragraph 22]

Paragraph 20 should also include staff in the first two instances when MEPs are mentioned, bearing in mind that staff can be subject to malicious action too, be it in the context of a mission with MEPs or when travelling alone, e.g. on a study trip.

VIII. Final outcome AFET Coordinators: DROI-SEDE key messages 2023 – 10 May 2023

Draft 2023 Commission Work Programme - DROI & SEDE Key messages

DROI:

Calls on the Commission:

- to prevent any violation linked to the EU policies, projects and funding in third countries, in particular EU migration policy related funding, including by creating a complaint mechanism for individuals or groups whose rights may have been violated by EU activities in these countries;
- to engage in proactive outreach to and support for journalist and independent media outlets in third countries with a view to supporting them, to make regular assessments of the press freedom environment in each respective third country;
- to defend the universality of human rights against its contestation from authoritarian and illiberal regimes;
- to make consistent use of clauses in agreements of the EU with third countries, which protect human rights with due attention to gender aspects, including closer monitoring and enforcement of human rights commitments, as well as a new complaint mechanism for alleged human rights abuses, to which stakeholders based in the concerned third countries would have access to;
- to ensure the implementation of a fully unified approach in the human rights protection and promotion in the world by EU Delegations and Member States' embassies;
- to propose an EU-wide visa scheme for human rights defenders at risk and their families, providing for flexible and quick procedures allowing for emergency evacuation;
- to present updated EU Guidelines on Human Rights Defenders, in view of the evolving risks faced by human rights defenders, and the improvement of their implementation by the EU institutions and Member States;
- to avoid using budget support to third countries' governments as an operational modality for cooperation with countries witnessing widespread violations of human rights and repression of human rights defenders;
- to present a programme building the capacity of Member States and partner countries to apply the principle of universal jurisdiction in their domestic legal systems;

- to expand the scope of the EU Global Human Rights Sanctions Regime in order to sanction individuals and entities responsible for large-scale corruption, or if that is not possible, to establish a dedicated anti-corruption sanction regime;

- to ensure a more dynamic use of the EU global human rights sanction regime (EU Magnitsky Act);

- to carry out a prompt, transparent and comprehensive assessment of the effectiveness and added value of the mandate of the Special Envoy (SE) for the promotion of freedom of religion or belief outside the EU, to provide the SE with adequate human and financial resources, and to adequately support the SE's institutional mandate, capacity and duties;

- to support actions aimed at ensuring full accountability for international crimes among others committed in connection with Russia's war of aggression against Ukraine, including through the establishment of an appropriate mechanism for the prosecution of the crime of aggression; in particular, to enhance its support for the investigations of the International Criminal Court on children and civilian abductions and other possible war crimes and crimes against humanity, as well as for the establishment of mechanisms to record the damages that Russian armed forces and their proxies have inflicted in Ukraine.

SEDE:

With regard to security and defence, calls on the EU and its institutions to implement its commitments to develop European defence, in particular those new defence initiatives accelerated in response to Russia's unprovoked war of aggression against Ukraine, and to report regularly on their implementation, including on:

1. the Commission's commitment to complete a fully-fledged European Defence Union;
2. the Member States progress in implementing the defence commitments in the Versailles Declaration,
3. the ongoing 21 CSDP Missions and Operations (12 Civilian and 9 Military),
4. the full implementation in respect of agreed timelines of the Strategic Compass,
5. the replenishment and use of the European Peace Facility (EPF) to provide military equipment for Ukraine and to provide complementary assistance to third country partners (especially where CSDP missions and operations are providing training or capacity building),
6. the full and coordinated pursuit of new and existing initiatives of the Member States or the European Commission, including those from the newly established Joint Defence Procurement Task Force and the urgent question on how to establish strong formal links between all to end fragmentation and increase interoperability, namely:
 1. the European Defence Fund (EDF),
 2. the European Defence Agency's Capability Development Plan (CDP) and Coordinated Annual Review of Defence (CARD),

3. the Permanent Structured Cooperation (PESCO),
4. the proposal for European defence industry reinforcement through common procurement act (EDIRPA),
5. the EU initiatives linked to the announced EU ammunition plan for Ukraine,
6. the anticipated proposal for a European Defence Investment Programme (EDIP).
7. the enhancement of EU-NATO defence cooperation.

In terms of urgent needs, stresses that EDIRPA can only be a first step towards improving the EDTIB's capacities to supply EU Member States with the products and quantities needed and should be complemented with further initiatives, including the envisaged long-term European Defence Investment Program (EDIP) for which an adequate funding needs to be ensured; further calls for the EU to enhance its capacities for responding to hybrid warfare, including for the detection and response to disinformation campaigns targeting the EU institutions and CSDP Missions and Operations.
