Resolution on the correct interpretation of Article 158 of the Amsterdam Treaty

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Article 158 and Annex 30 of the Amsterdam Treaty and noting the differences in meaning in the various languages,
- having considered opinion SJ218/98 of 27 July 1998 issued by the EP's Legal Service,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Regional Policy of 28 May 1998,
- whereas all the islands in the EU are restricted in their economic development and communications,
- whereas according to Agenda 2000 the only islands needing structural aid are those meeting macroeconomic rather than geographical criteria, as set out in the Amsterdam Treaty,
- whereas the EU has already taken account of natural handicaps as factors determining the fragility of an economy (outermost or under-populated regions),
- whereas the Isle of Wight has decided to bring the 'Article 158' case before the Court of Justice,
- 1. Hopes that the Court of Justice will interpret Article 158 in the light of Annex 30 and recognise that all islands, not only the '*least favoured*' ones should have the status of less-favoured regions of the EU, with all that entails;
- 2. Calls on the relevant committee to examine the issue.
