Motion for Resolution

Pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

by XXXX

on the forthcoming trial of Alexandr Nikitin

The European Parliament,

- having regard to its resolutions of 16 November 1995¹, 15 February 1996¹ and 1
 September 1996¹ on the harassment of the Bellona Foundation, the arrest of Alexandr Nikitin and the case of Alexandr Nikitin respectively,
- having regard to the European Convention on Human Rights and the Russian
 Constitution, particularly articles 15(3), 54 and 123(3) thereof,
- A. expressing its satisfaction that the case of Alexandr Nikitin is being tried by a civilian judge at the St. Petersburg City Court,
- B. understanding the importance of this case to the development of the Rule of Law in the new democratic Russia,
- C. whereas Mr Nikitin still remains in city arrest,
- D. whereas Mr. Nikitin is, for the eight time, being charged with treason, and the new

indictment has not been made available to him before the trial,

- E. whereas Mr. Nikitin has, on 26 July 1999, appealed to the European Court of Human Rights to remedy the violations of his rights under the European Convention on Human Rights,
- Asks the Russian authorities to guarantee Alexandr Nikitin an impartial and public trial based on the principles of the European Convention on Human Rights and the Russian Constitution;
- Urges the Russian authorities to give Alexandr Nikitin full access to the indictment and to the legal foundation of the charges against him;
- Calls on the Russian authorities to dismiss the charges against Alexandr Nikitin based on secret retroactive decrees;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, the Council, the Government of Russia, the Council of Europe and the Bellona Foundation.
