MOTION FOR AN URGENCY RESOLUTION

on the situation in Djibouti Prisons

The European Parliament,

- Recalling its earlier resolutions on prison conditions in Djibouti;
- A. Alarmed by the mission report (August 1999) of the International Federation of Human Rights Lique on prison conditions in Djibouti;
- B. Concerned that as many as 80% of the prisoners are detained under the notorious National Preventive Detention Act of 1991 and have not appeared in law courts since their arrest:
- C. Whereas a great number of those detained claim to be political prisoners;
- D. Whereas in September 1980, the Djibouti authorities passed a law to create a Prisons Commission responsible for the welfare of detainees and the improvement of prison conditions;
- implement the law passed on 16 1. Calls on the Diibouti Government to September 1980 and create a Prisons Commission with a view to improving prison conditions:
- 2. Urges the Djibouti Government to release all political prisoners and all long term detainees that have not been charged until now;
- 3. Appeals to the international community and the EU in particular to bring pressure to bear on the Djibouti authorities to improve prison conditions;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, the Council, the OAU and the Diibouti Government.
