With request for inclusion in the debate on topical And urgent subjects of major importance

On hooliganism during the Euro 2000

## The European Parliament,

- A. Considering that Belgian and Dutch authorities have been able to organize a large scale football tournament and associated festivities;
- B. Considering that Belgian and the Dutch authorities have shown themselves to be fully in control of public order and able to prevent structural disturbances during the Euro 2000 football festivities;
- C. Considering the joint action of the Belgian and Dutch Ministers of Home Affairs to see if a ban on travelling by condemned hooligans to other countries then their home country is possible;
- D. Considering that the vast majority of the soccer fans has through their behavior supported a peaceful Euro 2000;
- E. Considering that the disturbances in public space where caused by a very specific and limited group of hooligans
- 1. Welcomes the initiative measures taken by the Dutch and Belgian governments that have successfully resulted in a peaceful Euro 2000;
- 2. Welcomes the behavior of the vast majority of the soccer fans who assured a peaceful Euro 2000;
- 3. Asks the Commission together with the Council to inquire the possible following measures:
  - The Dutch-Belgian initiative for a ban on traveling by condemned hooligans toward football matches considered to be potentially risk-full;
  - all other measures that could help Europe and the Member States to prevent hooliganism (and related expressions of racism) violating the European area of Freedom and Security;
- 4. Requests its President to forward this resolution to the governments and parliaments of the Member States, in particular, and to the president of UEFA.
