B5-0311/2001

Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the approximation of laws on dispensers and connectors on LPG tanks

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the difficulties encountered by owners of motor vehicles running on methane and liquified petroleum gas when refuelling within the European Union,
 - having regard to Rule 59 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas there are differences in the systems for connecting dispenser and tanks in the various Member States,
- B. whereas Directive 70/221/EEC of 20 March 1970 relates only to protection devices on these tanks,
1. Considers that the above-mentioned directive is inadequate;
 2. Calls on the Commission, pursuant to Article 192, second paragraph, of the EC Treaty, to submit to it an appropriate legislative proposal designed to standardise equipment for supplying gas used as motor vehicle fuel within the Union.
