Resolution on the situation in Nepal

The European Parliament,

A. recognizing the deep aspirations of the people of Nepal to achieve a just and lasting peace in their country and for the installation of democracy and the attainment of progress and prosperity for all;

B. Deploring the interruption from 27 august of the previous ceasefire, that has caused people been kill and disapear, between the Governement of Nepal and the Communist Party of Nepal that aimed to enter a process of negociated settlement through dialogue;

C. Whereas the uniteral ceasefire by the Communist Party of Nepal from the 2th october 2003;

D. Welcoming the eventuality of Code of Conduct as was formulated by both parties on 13 March 2003 and appreciating the mutual commitment end efforts of both parties to carry out this Code of Conduct;

E. Recognizing the validity and great importance of convening a Round Table Conference of the representives of all parties, nationalities, regions, gender and all communities;

F. Encouraging the democratic establishment of Interim Governement consisting of the people's representatives;

G. Endorsing the election of a Constituent Assembly that will forge a constitution of the people, for the people and by the people;

1. Ask for the ceasefire and the recovering of a dialog between both sides;

2. Expresses its appreciation that the Government of Nepal and the Communist Party of Nepal should commit themeselves to pursue formal peace negotiations to a achieve a just and lasting peace for the benefit of the Nepalese people;

3. Recognizes and supports the convening of Round-Table Conference of people's representatives, the establishment of an Interim Governement and the election of a Constituent Assembly as essential democratic process on the path of achieving a just and lasting peace in Nepal;

4. Requests the Commission and Council to provide and facilitate support and assistance to the parties in carrying out formal peace negotiations and undertaking development, relief and rehabilitation programmes and projects to lay the ground for a just and lasting peace;

5. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council, the commission, the governments of the Members states and the Government of Nepal and the Comunist Party of Nepal
