MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on compulsory courses of driving instruction

European Parliament resolution on compulsory courses of driving instruction

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 48 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas in Italy and other EU Member States all persons of at least the minimum age required by law have to attend courses held by recognised driving schools in order to obtain a driving licence for all categories of motor vehicle, motor cycles etc.,
- B. whereas driving instruction is important in ensuring respect for the rules and hence greater road safety,
- 1. Considers that the Commission should bring in legislation extending the obligation to attend driving courses to all Member States, in order to ensure legislative uniformity in all EU countries.
