Rule 15

After the election of the Vice-Presidents, Parliament shall elect five Quaestors. The Quaestors shall be elected by the same procedure as the Vice-Presidents.

After the election of the Vice-Presidents, Parliament shall elect six Quaestors. The Quaestors shall be elected by the same procedure as the Vice-Presidents.

Amendment 2
Rule 182, paragraph 1

1. At the first committee meeting after the election of committee members pursuant to Rule 177, the committee shall elect a bureau consisting of a chairman and one, two or three vice-chairmen who shall be elected in separate ballots.
2. At the first committee meeting after the election of committee members pursuant to Rule 177, the committee shall elect a bureau consisting of a chairman and one, two, three or four vice-chairmen who shall be elected in separate ballots.
