Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the need for a change of course in EU climate policy

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and the Kyoto Protocol to the UNFCCC,
 - having regard to the Conference of the Parties to the UNFCCC to be held in Cancun,
 - having regard to the EU climate and energy package,
 - having regard to the InterAcademy Council report entitled ‘Climate Change Assessments, Review of the Processes and Procedures of the IPCC’,
 - having regard to Rule 120 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas there is a need to resume completely honest discussions on climate change following the discovery of serious errors and failings in the IPCC reports of 2007,
1. Considers that it is high time for the EU to make radical changes to its climate policy so that it takes heed of *all* relevant scientific opinions and views rather than listening only to the IPCC and UNFCCC, starting with the Conference in Cancun.
