## Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the Commission's immigrationist policy

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas, in a recent interview in the Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung, the Dalai Lama said that Europe was taking in too many migrants: 'Europe, for example Germany, cannot become an Arab country: Germany is Germany';
- B. whereas the Dalai Lama, the 1989 Nobel Peace Prize laureate, went on to say: 'When we look into the face of every single refugee, especially the children and women, we can feel their suffering. A human being who is a bit more fortunate has the duty to help them. On the other hand, there are too many now.';
- 1. Notes that those remarks by what is a universally acknowledged moral authority are extremely commonsensical;
- 2. Calls on the Commission to review its ill-considered immigrationist policy.
