## Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the negative impact of the Posted Workers Directive

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas in 2015, according to the National Commission to Combat Illegal Employment, the French authorities registered 286 025 posted workers an increase of 25% on the previous year;
- B. whereas this trend seems to be repeated in all the EU's largest economies;
- 1. Notes that host countries are taking in numbers of posted workers that their labour markets cannot cope with;
- 2. Calls on the Commission to note the negative impact of the Posted Workers Directive and repeal it, given that it is the cause of countless instances of fraud and unprecedented social dumping in the EU.
