Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the migrant relocation mechanism

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas French villages have been inundated with 'migrants' following the dismantling of the 'Calais jungle';
- B. whereas many of the so-called refugees have fake documents, come from sub-Saharan Africa, claim to be minors but are actually adults, sometimes have a criminal record in their country of origin and are single men, which is what led to the events in Cologne on New Year's Eve;
- C. whereas the EU's insistence on imposing migrant quotas on EU countries is totalitarian and at odds with democratic values;
- D. whereas, when Europeans have the opportunity to vote, as was recently the case in Hungary, the vast majority oppose the demographic submersion they are being threatened with;
- 1. Calls on the EU to let Member States decide on their own reception strategies; calls for the migrant relocation mechanism to be abolished;
- 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, the Council and the Member States.
