Is aware of the Commission's proposal for a European Labour Authority (ELA) and ***calls for such an authority to receive a sufficient budget of its own without resources being shifted to it from other important bodies***; calls on the Commission to step up its efforts to end unfair terms in employment contracts by addressing all abuses and loopholes; acknowledges the new proposal for a directive on Transparent and Predictable Working Conditions, which aims to establish new rights for all workers, particularly in order to improve working conditions for workers in new forms of employment and non-standard employment, while limiting the burdens on employers and maintaining labour market adaptability;

5. Is aware of the Commission's proposal for a European Labour Authority (ELA), ***but does not deem it a suitable solution that would comply with the principle of subsidiarity, as labour and wage legislation is the sole competence of the Member States***; calls on the Commission to step up its efforts to end unfair terms in employment contracts by addressing all abuses and loopholes; acknowledges the new proposal for a directive on Transparent and Predictable Working Conditions, which aims to establish new rights for all workers, particularly in order to improve working conditions for workers in new forms of employment and non-standard employment, while limiting the burdens on employers and maintaining labour market adaptability;
