on the urgent retraction and relaunch of the migration pact to incorporate the main elements of the Danish asylum plan

Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the urgent retraction and relaunch of the migration pact to incorporate the main elements of the Danish asylum plan

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the act amending the Aliens Act and the Return Act passed with bipartisan support in the Danish Parliament on 3 June 2021,
- having regard to Rule 143 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the Danish asylum plan would replace asylum processing in Denmark with reception centres in countries outside Europe, such as in Africa;
- B. whereas if an asylum seeker comes to Denmark and applies for asylum, they will be transferred to a reception centre in another country;
- C. whereas if the person is found to be in need of protection, they will also be granted protection in that country and therefore not granted asylum in Denmark;
- 1. Welcomes the Danish plan which, if successfully implemented, would lead to no asylum seekers in Denmark while fully respecting existing international conventions on the right to apply for asylum and receive protection;
- 2. Calls on the Commission, the Council and Parliament to retract and re-work the migration pact without delay so that it can be relaunched, incorporating the main elements of the Danish plan.
