MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the role of crew members in the procedure for reporting risks inherent in aviation safety

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 143 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas, in the field of civil aviation, it is in the interest of all – pilots, cabin crew and passengers alike – to have a high general level of safety in order to reduce accident risk factors;
- B. whereas under Article 4 of Regulation (EU) 376/2014 it is mandatory for occurrences which may represent a significant risk to aviation safety to be reported;
- C. whereas Article 4(6) of that regulation excludes cabin crew members from the list of persons expected to report in official reporting systems occurrences which may pose a significant risk to aviation safety;
 1. Considers that cabin crew members carry out a number of important safety and security tasks before, during and after a flight, and this must be duly recognised;
 2. Highlights that the list of risk occurrences related to the operation of the aircraft set out in Annex I to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/2018 describes the typical tasks of cabin crew;
 3. Suggests that Regulation (EU) 376/2014 be amended to add cabin crew members to the list of persons expected to report occurrences.
