Amendment

16a. Reiterates that fishing and aquaculture worldwide must be environmentally sustainable and managed in a way that is consistent with the objectives of achieving economic, social and employment benefits, and of contributing to the availability of food supplies; stresses that the collection of scientific and socio-economic data is fundamental to the sustainable management of fisheries; regrets that the recent Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/1614 of 15 September 2022 was adopted with insufficient data and stakeholder consultation; urges the Commission to suspend the application of this Implementing Regulation and to revise its decision in light of upcoming advice from the International Council for the Exploration of the Sea to be published in November 2022 and once a socio-economic impact assessment is available;
