**57a. Recalls its resolution of 7 June 2022 on the European External Action Service's climate change and defence roadmap<sup>1a</sup>, in particular recital S and paragraph 18 thereof; stresses that all sectors must contribute to reducing greenhouse gas emissions, including the defence sector; underlines the need for the defence sector to adapt to climate change in order to achieve the Union's climate neutrality objective, while maintaining operational effectiveness; calls on the Member States, in this respect, to introduce disaggregated mandatory reporting to the UNFCCC of greenhouse gas emissions by the defence sector;**
