European Parliament resolution on the growing hate crimes against LGBTIQ people across Europe in light of the recent homophobic murder in Slovakia (2022/2894(RSP))

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights of 1966,
- having regard to Articles 2, 3(1) and 5 of the Treaty on European Union<sup>1</sup>,
- having regard to Rule 132(2) of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas on 14 October 2022 two men were shot and killed outside a bar in Bratislava; whereas a woman was injured during the same incident and is currently recovering in hospital;
- B. whereas investigations have since concluded that they were murdered because of their sexual orientation;
- 1. Condemns unequivocally the senseless murders of the two men in Bratislava; extends its deepest condolences to the families and friends of the victims;
- 2. Denounces, in the strongest terms, the use or threat of use of violence against people because of their sexual orientation;
- 3. Reiterates that family law, including laws relating to marriage, is an exclusive competence of the Member States;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and to the Commission.
