Motion for a European Parliament resolution on a new European agenda to ensure Taiwan's survival and cease all ambiguity towards the country

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 143 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas China is waging an asymmetric war against Taiwan;
- B. whereas China is attempting to expand its authoritarian power into the Indo-Pacific region, to change the mentality of Taiwanese citizens through manipulation and to impose its own belief system;
- C. whereas Chinese ships and airplanes are patrolling the disputed areas in the East and South China Seas;
- D. whereas China is laying claim to that entire body of water;
- E. whereas Taiwan has never been ruled by China and has been a democratic state for a very long time;
- F. whereas, from a sociological standpoint, Taiwan is firmly against any suppression of its own democratic model by the People's Republic of China;
- G. whereas Taiwan's democracy is in danger;
- 1. Emphasises the need for EU Member States to build closer ties with Taiwan, expanding and deepening cooperation;
- 2. Calls on the European Council to develop a new EU agenda to ensure Taiwan's survival and cease all ambiguity towards the country.
