## B9-0265/2023

Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the implementation of measures for tackling early school leaving and promoting education in the European Union

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 143 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the early school leaving rate is one of the main challenges facing education in the countries of the European Union, with Italy ranked third with a rate of 12.7% in 2021;
- B. whereas the European average of 9.7% is still far from acceptable in view of the objectives to reduce the early school leaving rate to at least 9%, deliver on the universal right to study and increase the literacy rate;
- 1. Urges the Commission to help the Member States by supporting their school systems through initiatives, projects and investments;
- 2. Calls on the Commission to implement measures aimed at dissuading young people from leaving school early by providing economic support to families, particularly those facing the greatest economic hardship.
