**Motion for a European Parliament resolution on implementing measures to step up cooperation between the EU Member States' law enforcement agencies with a view to tackling cybercrime**

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 143 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas digital crime is increasing dramatically throughout Europe; for example, according to data released by the Italian postal police, cyberattacks shot up by 246 % in Italy between 2019 and 2020;
- B. whereas national law enforcement agencies often lack the requisite instruments to properly carry out checks;
- C. whereas cyberspace is in a constant state of flux and, owing in part to the poor traceability of online activities, criminals take advantage of 'grey areas' on the internet;
- 1. urges the Commission to take measures to step up cooperation between the EU Member States' law enforcement agencies;
- 2. calls on the Commission to support Member States in combating cybercrime, which is often a cross-border phenomenon.
