Motion for a European Parliament resolution on Albanians immigrating to the European Union

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the agreement of 17 May 2005 between the European Community and the Republic of Albania on the readmission of persons residing without authorisation¹,
- having regard to Rule 143 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas 'between 2010 and 2019, more than 193 000 Albanians applied for asylum in the European Union'²;
- B. whereas 'the country still grapples with blood feuds and revenge killings, domestic abuse, and so-called honour-based violence's;
- C. whereas 'the visa waivers granted in 2010 for Albania and in 2017 for Georgia have led to a disproportionate amount of irregular migrants coming to France compared to other countries'4:
- 1. Notes the decrease in irregular arrivals to the UK, notably as a result of a bilateral agreement⁵;
- 2. Expresses its concern about 'the apparent increase in unaccompanied Albanian children seeking asylum'⁶;
- 3. Urges the Commission to discuss these asylum applications (notably those by unaccompanied minors), improving the return rate and statistics, and the impact of the visa liberalisation mechanism with Albania⁷.
