

#### Motion for a resolution

E. whereas the MFF revision reduces the maximum annual amount of the EGF from EUR 186 million to EUR 30 million (in 2018 prices), as laid down in Article 8 of Council Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2020/2093 as amended by Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2024/765; whereas all institutions need to ensure that, despite these cuts, workers made redundant can count on EU solidarity via support of the EGF;
