- issued for all nine JUs, an unqualified (“clean”) audit opinion on the reliability of the accounts, as well as on the legality and regularity of the payments and revenue underlying the year 2020
- drew attention with an “emphasis of matter” paragraph for F4E to the fact that any changes in key assumptions for the estimate could lead to significant cost increases and/or further delays in the implementation of the ITER project
- observed various matters needing improvement in the areas of budgetary and financial management, in-kind contributions, grant payments, procurement procedures, human resources and sound financial management
- noted that In 2020, the JUs took appropriate measures to maintain business continuity during the COVID-19 pandemic and mitigate its possible impact on their service delivery.

Regional policy is part of Chapter 5 in the European Court of Auditors' Annual Report entitled "Economic, social and territorial cohesion – MFF heading 1b". The main policy instrument under this policy field is the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF). The Commission's Directorate-General on Regional and Urban Policy, DG REGIO, implements EU funds under the field of regional policy, which represents almost a quarter of the total EU budget, and is a major source of public investments in many Member States. DG REGIO's expenditure is implemented mainly in shared management. DG REGIO delivers its objectives through management of programmes financed under the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF), the Cohesion Fund (CF) and from 2021 the Just Transition Fund (JTF).



For the 2014-2020 programming period, DG REGIO estimated risk at payment linked to the 2020 relevant expenditure is calculated at 2.1% / 2.6% taking into account the financial corrections already made. In the 2020 AMPR, the Commission reported a combined overall risk at payment of between 1.9 % and 2.4 % for this MFF sub-heading based on DG REGIO and DG EMPL estimated amounts at risk and their KPIs. For the second year in a row, the Commission's error estimates fall within ECA's own error range estimate. At the same time, according to ECA, the rates reported in the AMPR (as well as the specific rates reported in both DG EMPL and DG REGIO AARs) are below their estimated level of error, estimated at 3.5%.

During this hearing, ECA Member Pietro Russo will also present ECA's assessment on the performance of the EU Budget at the end of 2020 for the chapter on Economic, Social and Territorial Cohesion, which focuses on the

European Social Fund (ESF). CONT Members are reminded that this fund is not under Commissioner Ferreira's portfolio and will not be able to answer questions in this regard.

The partnership agreement, signed in Cotonou on 23 June 2000 for an initial period of 20 years, is the framework governing EU's relations with ACP (African, Caribbean and Pacific States) countries and OCTs, currently extended until 30 November 2021.

Its main objective is to reduce and ultimately eradicate poverty. After an internal reorganisation within the Commission, DG INTPA became responsible for the implementation of the EDFs (previously DG DEVCO).



For MFF 2021-2027 development aid to the ACP and the Overseas Countries and Territories (OCT) will be integrated into the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument (NDICI/Global Europe). However, ongoing projects within the 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th EDFs will not be integrated into the EU general budget, but will continue to be implemented separately and be subject to a separate discharge resolution until their closure.

For 2020, the total value of expenditure subject to audit was almost EUR 4 billion.

According to the findings of the ECA 2020 Annual Report related to the activities funded by the 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th EDFs, the expenditure for the financial year 2020 is materially affected by error and the testing of transactions produced an estimated overall level of error of 3,8% (3,5% in 2019).

The ECA issued an adverse opinion on the legality and regularity of expenditure. The highest estimated level of error, by error type, was due to the absence of essential supporting documents.

3. ECA SPECIAL REPORT 24/2021: PERFORMANCE-BASED FINANCING IN COHESION POLICY: WORTHY AMBITIONS, BUT OBSTACLES REMAINED IN THE 2014-2020 PERIOD

Cohesion policy's main objective is to strengthen the economic, social and territorial Cohesion by reducing disparities between the level of development of the regions. Making Cohesion policy more performance-based has been a shared objective of the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission since first adopted on the legislative package for the 2014-2020 European Structural and Investment (ESI) Funds in December 2013. In this period,

Cohesion policy was delivered through three of the five ESI Funds: the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF), the European Social Fund (ESF) and the Cohesion Fund (CF).

Under this framework, three instruments gave Member States financial incentives to achieve results, optimise their use of funding, and comply with the EU's policy objectives. As follows 1) 'ex-ante conditionalities' ('EACs', requirements to fulfil specific prerequisites to create an investment-friendly environment from the start of the programmes), 2) mandatory performance reserves (roughly € 20 billion, or 6% of Cohesion spending to be released for priority axes and other programmes), and 3) performance-based funding models (which linked EU financial support to pre-defined outputs/results).

The Court examined whether the before mentioned instruments were well designed to incentivise performance and shift the focus to achieving results when implementing the EU budget. The audit also investigated the effective use of these financial instruments by the Commission and the Member States, as well as if their use made a difference in the way Cohesion funding was allocated and disbursed.

As part of the examination, the Court selected 14 operational programs (OPs) from four Member States (Germany, Italy, Poland and Romania) covering both ERDF/CF and ESF funding under five thematic objectives closely linked to Europe 2020 and eight related action plans for EACs.

The general conclusion was that the Commission and Member States had been only partially successful in using the three instruments to make the financing of Cohesion policy more performance-based.

Based on the findings, the Court recommends the Commission to:

- monitor Member States' fulfilment of enabling conditions for the 2021-2027 period through its representative in the monitoring committee for Cohesion policy programmes, and report to the European Parliament and to the Council on Member States' fulfilment of enabling conditions and its own enforcement activities;
- inform Member States at an early stage about the approach to be applied for the mid-term review, and take any relevant findings of the 2024 evaluation of the Member States' use of the RRF for its 2025 mid-term reviews;
- clarify the rules underlying the 'financing not linked to costs' funding model for Member States;
- clarify the approach for providing assurance and guarantee effective application of the rules governing the internal market on EU funding through the 'financing not linked to costs' model

In its replies to the findings and recommendations, the Commission accepted the recommendations by the ECA and will implement them. The Commission will build on the lessons learned and pay particular attention to the preparation and implementation of the recovery and resilience plans by the Member States as well as to the mid-term review for the 2021-2027 programmes.

The ECA SR will be presented by ECA reporting Member Ladislav Balko.

The Chair raised the following two issues:

- The agenda of the CONT meeting on the same day (30 November) had been changed in order to allow the President of ECA to explain his and the Court's views on the article in Liberation from 26 November. It would be correct for the CONT Committee to analyse the allegations based on facts.

- The answers provided by Commissioner Johansson concerning certain NGO's and their non-compliance with rules were not satisfactory.
