Addressing climate change through internal policies and cooperation with international partner is a key priority for the EU. The EU committed to reducing greenhouse gas emissions under the Kyoto Protocol and work towards a global climate-mitigation target of limiting global warming to “well below” 2°C under the Paris Agreement. In 2011, the Commission announced its objective for increasing the proportion of the EU budget related to climate to at least 20% for 2014-2020. In 2021, the Commission reported that it had met the target, having spent €216 billion (20.1 %) on climate-relevant measures. The 2021-2027 EU budget includes an increased target of 30 % on climate action.

The objective of the audit was to determine whether the Commission had reported relevant and reliable climate-spending information for 2014-2020. The Court examined how the Commission applied its methodology in assessing climate spending, as well, as how the reported expenditure contributed to climate action. Furthermore, the expected changes in tracking climate spending post-2020 were also reviewed. The Court also produced this report in order to help the Commission improve the future reporting on climate spending.



Overall, the reporting on climate spending was assessed to be unreliable. It involved significant approximation and tracked only the potential positive impact on climate without evaluating the final contribution to EU climate goals. The analysis indicated that the Commission overstated climate spending by at least €72 billion, over 80 % of which was from agricultural funding. This means that around 13 % of the 2014-2020 EU budget was spent on climate action, which was well below the 20% target.

The European External Action Service (EEAS) is a functionally autonomous body of the European Union, separate from the General Secretariat of the Council and from the Commission. It is treated as an institution for the purposes of the Financial Regulation and therefore, subject to the procedure of discharge provided for in Article 319 of the TFEU and in Article 263 of the Financial Regulation.

The EEAS is placed under the authority of the High Representative/Vice-President (HRVP) of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy, Mr Josep Borrell Fontelles, who is invited to the CONT meeting for a discharge hearing with Members on the implementation of EEAS budget and activities during the financial year 2021.



In accordance with the timetable for the discharge procedure, the written questions addressed to the EEAS were sent on 10 October 2022. The answers received from the EEAS were sent to CONT Members on 27 October, and are available on the CONT website.

The questions from the questionnaire deal with budgetary and financial management, internal management, performance and internal control, human resources including equality and staff well-being, digitalisation, cybersecurity and data protection, buildings and security, environment and sustainability, interinstitutional cooperation, communication and multilingualism.

- The EEAS 2021 Annual Activity Report;

Executive Vice President Timmermans is responsible for the European Green Deal. This key policy of the Von der Leyen Commission aims at transforming the EU into a modern, resource-efficient and competitive economy, ensuring:

- no net emission of greenhouse gases by 2050;
- economic growth decoupled from resource use;
- no person and no place left behind.

Financially speaking, most expenditure related to achieving these targets does not fall directly under Mr Timmermans' responsibility. The importance of the European Green Deal is however significant, and expenditure from EU funds and instruments must meet specific goals to ensure its implementation. For example, one third of the EUR 1.8 trillion investments from the NextGenerationEU Recovery Plan, and the EU's Multi-annual Financial Framework will finance the European Green Deal.

Tracking that all investments indeed meet the green requirements and that the EU funds are used to meet the ambitious targets is of the utmost importance. The European Court of Auditors made important observations in this regard in its Annual Report for 2021, and in several special reports.

6. CONT MISSION TO POLAND (18 - 20 JULY 2022)

The mission's objective was first to focus on ongoing developments in Poland concerning the protection of the EU budget in relation to the Rule of law-conditional Regulation.

The objective was also to include a visit to Frontex, which has its headquarters in Warsaw, in order to evaluate the progress made by the Agency in fulfilling the conditions laid down in the 2020 discharge report, to support mutual cooperation between the Agency and the Commission, and to understand Frontex' strategy in the framework of its immense staff increase over a short period of time.

- Members emphasised their wish to see EU recovery funds reach as many people and organisations in Poland, given all that they have been doing to help those fleeing the war against Ukraine and the damage done by the pandemic.
- However, Members highlighted that the European Parliament needs to ensure that EU taxpayers' money is protected and fairly distributed, and raised concerns following their visit to Poland. It seems that there were systemic problems caused by the Government that prevent Poland from meeting all conditions for receiving the EU money.
- Members made an effort to look from all angles at the distribution and management of EU funds in Poland, to check whether there were systems in place to protect the EU's financial interests. Members focused on current EU funding under shared management, and found that the systems to protect and control the EU funds were in place. However, Members asked the Government to make up for the damage done to SMEs that were made victims of the misuse of funds by letterbox companies in cooperation with big companies.
- After speaking with Government and opposition politicians, prosecutors and judges, NGO representatives, journalists, paying and oversight authorities, as well as the Polish Supreme Audit, Members underlined they had to analyse the complaints and concerns around particular cases in-depth. There were signs that the distribution of public funds, including EU money, was increasingly politicised, and that the complicated criteria for the receipt of EU funds hampered its fair distribution.
- Members expressed their fears about the lack of an independent judiciary, and political interventions into the work of judges and prosecutors, which gave them reason to be concerned about a growing systemic problem with the independent verification of the spending of EU funds. Members expected respect for the separation of powers, which is a fundamental pillar of European law. Members also called on the Polish government to urgently start cooperating with the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO), so that EU-wide tax fraud and money laundering schemes could be properly prosecuted.

- Following the revelation of the restrictions in place on Poland's national court of auditors, Members emphasised that it was crucial for the audit authorities to be independent, protected and empowered to do all audits as they deemed appropriate. Members expressed strong concerns about the ongoing political pressure on members of the court, the prohibition on nominations of court members and the necessary staff, and the refusal of their access to necessary documents in order to prevent the court of auditors fulfils its mandate.
- Members concluded they would follow-up on the information they received during their visit, and would include it in 2023's discharge process, as well as passing it on to the Commission, the European Court of Auditors, the EU anti-fraud watchdog OLAF and the EPPO.

Under Commissioner Kyriakides' responsibility, the Commission played a key role in the successful vaccine role out in the EU in 2021, notably through the joint procurement of vaccines. Also, the Commissioner was responsible for the Emergency Support Instrument, that supported Member States to mitigate the immediate consequences of the pandemic and anticipate the needs related to the recovery. In addition, under the Commissioner's responsibility, the EU Digital COVID Certificate Regulation entered into application on 1 July 2021 that facilitated the safe free movement of citizens within the EU during the pandemic.

In 2021, expenditure in the policy area Public Health increased in comparison to previous years, given the new EU4Health Programme with an envelope of EUR 5.3 billion (2021-2027), which is more than eleven times higher than the previous Health Programme (EUR 452 million for 2014-2020). As in previous years, about 80% of the 2021 budget were implemented by an executive agency.

DG SANTE's spending in the policy area Food Safety is based on the Single Market Programme (SMP) through a dedicated food chain strand of EUR 1,7 billion (2021-2027). The funding of the Food Safety policy remained relatively stable compared to the previous MFF with a budget of EUR 1,8 billion (2014-2020). For the first time in 2021, DG SANTE delegated large parts of the budget for Single Market Programme to the European Health and Digital Executive Agency (about 74%).



The member of the Court of Auditors present at this hearing is Ms Joelle Elvinger, responsible for the SR on Vaccine procurement. The Court's Annual Report did not contain findings relevant for this hearing.

Hearing of Keit Pentus-Rosimannus, candidate nominated by Estonia

The Members of the European Court of Auditors are appointed for a term of six years. In accordance with Article 286(2) of the TFEU the Council, after consulting the European Parliament, shall adopt the list of Members drawn up in accordance with the proposals made by each Member State.

Appointments to the ECA are submitted to Parliament's plenary on the basis of a report from CONT. The report takes into account the requirement of Article 286(1) of the TFEU: "*The Members of the Court of Auditors shall be chosen from among persons who belong or have belonged in their respective States to external audit bodies or who are especially qualified for this office. Their independence must be beyond doubt.*", as well as other considerations.

In Parliament, the procedure is defined in Rule 129 RoP. According to Rule 129 (1), "candidates nominated as Members of the Court of Auditors shall be invited to make a statement before the committee responsible and to answer questions put by members. The committee shall vote on each nomination separately by secret ballot."

In preparation for the hearing, the candidate has been asked to answer a questionnaire prepared by CONT.

The hearing is structured as follows:

- Opening of the hearing by the Chair;
- The candidate will give an opening statement (maximum of 8 minutes);
- The CONT Rapporteur and shadow-rapporteurs will put questions to the candidate using the ping-pong system;
- Other members will question the candidate (catch-the-eye if time permits);
- Concluding remarks by the Chair.

After the hearing, the committee will hold an evaluation of the candidate in camera, and then proceed to vote on his appointment.

According to Rule 129 (1), the committee shall vote by secret ballot. Members shall indicate whether they give a favourable opinion, a negative opinion or abstain.

The format of reports on candidates for membership of the Court of Auditors is defined in Parliament's resolution of 4 February 2014, which implies that amendments cannot be tabled for this report.

The draft report will be finalised, according to the outcome of the evaluation and the vote in committee. The candidate's CV and the answers to the questionnaire are annexed to the report.

The report for plenary will state that Parliament delivers either a favourable or a negative opinion on the appointment of the candidate. The vote in Plenary is planned for November II (21 - 24 November). The draft report is available on the CONT website.

The CONT Committee has requested to draw up an own-initiative report on the protection of the European Union's financial interests. The INI report is based on, among other sources, the Commission's 33rd annual report on the Protection of EU's financial interests (PIF report 2021), presented on 13 October 2022 by Commissioner Hahn in the CONT Committee. The Rapporteur, Ms Pignedoli, will present her draft report in Committee, and hear from the Shadow rapporteurs and the other Members. Commission's representatives will also be present in the circumstance.

The Rapporteur's analysis includes considerations on the the main 2021 milestones, amongst them the beginning of the operational activities of the EPPO, the entry into force of the Regulation on the general regime of conditionality for the protection of the Union budget and of the amended OLAF Regulation, the Commission's proposal for a targeted amendment (recast) of the Financial Regulation, and the adoption of the Recovery and Resilience Facility Regulation, which allows, together with the new MFF , the deployment of an unprecedented amount of resources with a corresponding increase of the risk of fraud and mismanagement.

In her draft report, Ms Pignedoli has relaunched topics already highlighted in the previous Parliament's resolutions such as the review of the detection trends for fraudulent and not-fraudulent irregularities and the transposition of the PIF, AML-CFT and Whistle-blowers Directives. The presented text includes a section on the major threats, such as transnational and organised crime and corruption, in particular perpetrated via cross-border modalities and use of off-shore, which make their countering more demanding and resource-absorbing and their impact more harmful on the civil society and the legal economy. Another section is devoted to the need to enhance the support that IT, digitalisation and related technologies are expected to provide to the protection of the financial interests. Amongst the calls on the Commission, there is also the request to submit a legislative proposal on mutual administrative assistance in those areas of European fund spending that are not yet endowed with this important tool.

In approaching and assessing the overall state of play of the protection of the Union's financial interests, the draft report embraces a perspective consistent with the design of the anti-fraud architecture, shaped in the last years by the co-legislators, and whose main structure has reached a major milestone with the starting of the operational activities of the EPPO, in June 2021. The Rapporteur reiterates the need for a Commission reporting tool more responsive to the need of bringing into light the dynamics and processes of such architecture. The report stresses that the anti-fraud composite institutional structure has been designed to detect, prevent and combat fraud and other misconducts affecting the EU financial interests by interaction amongst the multi-layered network of cooperation: the horizontal coordination amongst EU institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and the vertical relationships between EU authorities and national authorities, and between EU authorities and international organisations.
