3.1 Extension of the term of office of the COVI Special Committee

At their meeting on 18 January 2023, the Conference of Presidents decided to endorse the request of a three-month extension of the committee's term of office.

3.2 Follow-up to Pfizer CEO BOURLA's refusal to participate in a Committee hearing and next steps on the lack of transparency on joint procurement of vaccines - invitation of President VON DER LEYEN for an in-camera meeting to Parliament

At their meeting on 11 January 2023, the COVI Committee Coordinators decided with majority according to Rule 214 the following:

- To initiate actions, by a letter from the COVI Special Committee Chair to President METSOLA, necessary for the suspension or withdrawal of the long-term access badges of Pfizer to Parliament, pursuant to Rule 123 (3) of Parliament's Rules of Procedure;
- To provide mandate to the COVI Special Committee Chair to address a letter to President METSOLA requesting to invite President VON DER LEYEN for an in-camera meeting to Parliament with a view to providing answers on transparency and accountability on joint procurement of vaccines, including answers given for preliminary negotiations for the procurement agreements for vaccines.

By two letters of the COVI Special Committee Chair to President METSOLA, both matters have been referred to the Parliament's governing bodies and Secretary-General for decision.

3.3 COVI ad hoc delegation to South Africa and Ethiopia

Committee Coordinators adopted the draft programme and list of participants of the ad hoc delegation to Cape Town/South Africa and Addis Ababa/Ethiopia from 20 to 26 February 2023. The delegation would be composed of seven COVI Members, including the COVI Chair, plus the DEVE Committee Chair, who would be replaced by a DEVE Vice-Chair.

1. Adoption of the agenda

Decision: The Coordinators adopted the draft agenda in the form shown in these minutes.

2. Chair's announcements

2.1. Letter dated 22 December 2022 by Ms Cooke, Executive Director of the EMA on the US Vaccines Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) system

The Chair reported that she had received a letter by Ms Cooke, Executive Director of the EMA, on a reply to the letter dated 1st December 2022 from Ms DONATO, Mr KOLAKUŠIĆ and Mr SINČIĆ on the US Vaccines Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) system.

2.2. Conference of Presidents decision on the COVI request for an extension of the Committee's term of office

The Chair reported that, following the last postponement of the decision by the Conference of Presidents on the COVI request for an extension of the term of office for three months, the aforementioned request would be on the agenda of the meeting of the Conference of Presidents on 18 January 2023.

3. Adoption of the draft programme and list of participants of the ad hoc delegation to South Africa and Ethiopia

At their meeting on 12 September 2022, the Committee Coordinators agreed to organise in the first half of 2023 an ad-hoc delegation to Cape Town, South Africa and, if possible, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia in week 8 of 2023.

At its meeting on 24 November 2022, the Conference of Presidents (CoP) authorised a seven Members ad hoc delegation including the COVI Chair and the COVI rapporteur, plus the DEVE Chair, from 20 to 26 February 2023, on an exceptional basis, on the condition that the security situation on the ground prior to departure allowed for the mission to go ahead and that the instructions and risk mitigating measures of the Mission Security Assessment be respected given that South Africa and Ethiopia were listed as 'level 4-high' counties by the EEAS.

Decision: Committee Coordinators approved the draft programme and decided the following:

- the five places for the COVI Members be allocated in accordance with the rolling d'Hondt system;
- one seat by EPP which was not filled to be allocated to the Greens/EFA, and given that the COVI Rapporteur was not available to participate in the ad hoc delegation, the vacant seat to be allocated to the Renew Europe according to the rolling d'Hondt system.

The final composition of the COVI Members in the ad hoc delegation: EPP 1 Member; S&D 2 Members; Renew Europe 2 Members; Greens/EFA 1 Member, and the COVI Chair.

The DEVE Chair would also participate in the COVI ad hoc delegation, in line with the above-mentioned Conference of Presidents' decision.

4. Follow-up to Pfizer CEO BOURLA's refusal to participate in a Committee hearing and next steps on the lack of transparency on joint procurement of vaccines

In response to Dr. Albert BOURLA's cancellation of his participation in the COVI Committee hearing on 10 October 2022, at their meeting on 25 October 2022, the Committee Coordinators decided to extend a second invitation to Dr. BOURLA for an exchange of views with COVI Special committee Members in early 2023.

By letter dated 2 December 2022, Dr. BOURLA declined to the second Committee invitation for participating in a COVI Committee public hearing which the Committee felt necessary. Committee Coordinators considered, inter alia, that so far there were no answers given for preliminary negotiations for the procurement agreements for vaccines, with particular emphasis on the 3rd contract with Pfizer/BioNTech and, on the texts messages exchanged, his participation was of a great interest for the committee, as the largest producer and supplier of COVID-19 vaccines to the European Union.

Decision: Committee Coordinators decided by majority, pursuant to Rule 214:

- a. to initiate actions, by a letter from the Chair to President METSOLA, necessary for the suspension or withdrawal of the long-term access badges of Pfizer to Parliament, pursuant to Rule 123 (3) of Parliament's Rules of Procedure; and
- b. that the Chair address a letter to President METSOLA requesting to invite President VON DER LEYEN for an in-camera meeting to Parliament with a view to providing answers on transparency, including

answers given for preliminary negotiations for the procurement agreements for vaccines.

5. COVI Committee Working Programme 2023 & experts for the hearing on ‘One Health’ and the hearing on The resilience of (international) supply chains of vaccines and critical medical goods, and the question of health-related EU strategic autonomy’

At their meeting on 29 November 2022, Committee Coordinators adopted the committee work programme for 2023 with a timeline for scheduling hearings, workshops and exchange of views for the first half 2023, provided that an extension term of office of the Committee for three months would be granted.

- Decision:** The Committee Coordinators decided on the list of experts (attached in Annex 2¹) to be invited to the following public hearings:
- on ‘*The resilience of (international) supply chains of vaccines and critical medical goods, and the question of health-related EU strategic autonomy*’, including an exchange of views on ‘the role of BARDA during the COVID-19 pandemic in the United States’, and
 - on ‘One Health’.
