The meeting opened at 15.15 on Wednesday 20 February 2013, with Doris Pack (Chair) in the chair.

**3. Chair's announcements**

The Chair announced the departure of two members of the secretariat Ms Inese Kriskane and Ms Rita Soares.

Mrs. Pack gave a short briefing on the first informal trilogue for "YES Europe" - the Union programme on Youth, Education, Training and Sport. Ms. Julie Anderson, Chair of the Education Working Group of the Council, had presented the Council's mandate, commenting that the "modified partial general approach" incorporated about one-third of the amendments adopted by CULT in its report. The remainder of the meeting had been devoted to discussing a large number of Articles where the differences between the two institutions were relatively small, meaning that fair progress had been made. For the points where there was common agreement between the institutions, the Council would confirm its final position in the Working Group. The next meeting was planned for 19 March, but an earlier second trilogue might take place during the March Strasbourg week.

#### **4. Exchange of views with Miguel Angel Martínez Martínez (Chair of the Bureau Contact Group) on the House of European History Project**

Mr. Martinez Martinez presented the current state of the House of European History Project. He raised the possibility of organising a conference uniting historians and stakeholders to raise awareness of the project. The Members expressed their support for this initiative and the importance of ensuring that the House promotes a pluralist account of European history.

Mrs. Kammerevert presented her draft report and responded to points made by Members. She stressed the possibility of reviewing the Audiovisual Media Services Directive (AVMSD) in light of recent technological developments and the need for graduated regulation; that content providers must ensure accessibility of content, as well as the promotion of media pluralism and cultural diversity. Members pointed out that other technological devices such as tablets and smart phones are also affected by the AVMSD and underlined the need for appropriate regulatory mechanisms to address issues such as copyright, protection of minors and quality control. The European Commission representative (Ms. Boix Alonso, DG EAC) confirmed that the Commission's Green Paper on this topic is still under discussion, is large in scope and will address the challenges of other technological devices.

Mrs. Sanchez-Schmid outlined her initial thoughts on her INI report. She planned to underline the importance of innovation and new technologies in these sectors; the need for better data on employment and the economic viability of these sectors to promote growth; resolving the lack of funding with use of the Structural Funds and the need for improving competitiveness and synergies within these often-fragmented sectors. The Commission (Ms. Nigge, DG EAC) expressed her hope that the draft report would propose evidence-based policies and the implementation of transversal strategies in order to stimulate growth and jobs in these sectors.

### **2. Delegation to Inari, Finland, 1- 4 April 2013**

The coordinators took note that their request for derogation from the Bureau rules in force so that travel to Helsinki could take place on Monday 1 April and the delegation in Inari begin on 2 April had been approved and that a final draft programme and list of participants would be presented for approval at the next coordinators' meeting.

### **3. Delegation to Croatia, 29 April-3 May 2013**

The coordinators decided:

- to revise their proposal so that the delegation would be confined to Zagreb
- since 1 May is a public holiday in Croatia, to seek derogation from the Bureau rules so that the delegation might begin with arrival in Zagreb on the evening of Sunday 28 April and end in the early afternoon of Tuesday 30 April
- that the groups would send the names of Members planning to take part in these delegations to the secretariat by 12 noon on Friday 1 March.

### **4. Delegations to Kosice, Slovakia, 15-19 July 2013 and Marseille, France, 28-31 October 2013**

The coordinators decided that the groups should send the names of Members planning to take part in these delegations to the secretariat by 12 noon on Thursday 14 March.

### **5. Proposals for public hearings**

The coordinators:

- recalled their earlier decision that, in 2013, the Committee would not propose a programme of public hearings covering the whole of the year but would instead seek authorisation to hold these one by one as necessary (under Article 2 of the Bureau decision on hearings)
- decided to organise hearings in the course of future Committee meetings on "Internationalisation of higher education" and "The European cultural and creative sectors as sources of economic growth and jobs".

### **6. Studies 2013**

In addition to the research unit work programme for 2013 approved by the Committee in the course of its last meeting, the coordinators decided to ask Policy Department B to draw up studies or briefing notes on the following subjects, the scope and precise titles to be agreed in consultation with the relevant Members and with any other interested committees:

- Policies to support investigative journalism and free and pluralistic media (consultation with Mr. Tavares and LIBE committee)
- The book market in Europe (consultation with Mr. Løkkegaard and IMCO committee)

## **7. LUX Prize 2013**

The coordinators:

- took note of a report on the LUX Prize competition in 2012
- approved the attached proposal from the LUX Prize secretariat for the selection panel for the 2013 competition.

## **8. Jury Invitation - European Youth Capital 2016**

The coordinators decided that Mrs. Neved'alová should represent the Committee on the selection jury for the European Youth Capital event.

## **9. Citizens' Agora on Youth Unemployment**

The coordinators:

- took note of a letter from President Schulz to the Chair, informing her that, on the basis of a joint proposal from Vice-President Durant and himself, the Bureau had decided on 12 December last that the EP should organise (probably in November 2013) a Citizens' Forum AGORA on the subject of "Youth Unemployment".
- postponed a decision about the precise form of its participation in this event until it has received further information about it from Vice-President Durant (responsible for the Citizens' Forum in the Bureau).

## **10. Invitation to Irish Presidency Sports Conference - 7 March 2013**

The coordinators decided that Mr. Fisas Ayxela (depending on availability) might represent the Committee at this event.

## **11. Apple and censorship**

The coordinators:

- heard Mr. Løkkegaard speak about recent cases in which Apple had rejected from its iBookstore platform e-books and iPad apps depicting naked men and women, on the grounds that company guidelines prohibit sexually explicit images; and express his concern that, because of Apple's powerful market position, this amounted to a new form of censorship;
- noted that the Commission has already taken a public position on this issue, namely that, while blocking of such goods might be a matter for regret, Apple's actions are not in breach of any existing EU laws;
- invited Mr. Løkkegaard to prepare a draft open letter on this which coordinators might sign.

## **12. Sports events in Belarus**

The coordinators:

- heard Mr. Løkkegaard express his unhappiness at the decision of the relevant sports federation to invite Belarus to host the 2014 world ice hockey championship;
- noted that the Parliament had already adopted a resolution which addressed the broader issue of staging sports competitions in states which do not respect democratic values and human rights;
- invited Mr. Løkkegaard to prepare a draft letter, which they might sign, to be sent to a range of sports federations and associations, drawing their attention to this issue and to the Parliament's resolution on it.

### **13. Invitation to Belsat to attend a future CULT meeting**

The coordinators decided to invite representatives of TV Belsat (an independent TV channel and subsidiary of Polish public television TVP, broadcasting in Belarus since 2007) to a future Committee meeting for an exchange of views.
