COORDINATORS' DECISIONS

25 October 2022

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1. Points system for appointing rapporteurs for reports and opinions

The updated points' table will be included in the next Coordinators' notes.

2. Chair's announcements

The Coordinators:

- heard the Chair report on a letter received from the Rector of the University of Zagreb, asking for support against recent bills claimed to endanger the institutional autonomy of universities and academic freedom in Croatia, and entrusted the Secretariat to collect further information on this issue before taking a decision on how to proceed;
- heard the Chair stress the need for the CULT report on the “Implementation of the New European Agenda for Culture and the EU Strategy for International Cultural Relations” to be voted in the Committee on Monday, 14 November 2022, in order to be ready before the Council’s adoption of the new European Agenda for Culture 2023-2026, and decided to hold the CULT Committee vote on the report that day;
- heard the Chair report on two planned own-initiative reports of the EMPL Committee on vocational training and early childhood education and care that are potentially infringing upon CULT competences, and decided to entrust the Chair to do the necessary to defend the CULT Committee’s interests and request adequate association to the former and object to the latter in its current design;
- heard the Chair report on the state of play of the European Media Freedom Act, which has been referred to the CULT Committee as lead Committee, with the LIBE Committee likely raising a conflict of competences and requesting association pursuant to Rule 58 of the EP’s Rules of Procedure, and IMCO requesting association pursuant to Rule 57; entrusted the Chair to defend CULT’s interest in the forthcoming negotiations once these requests will have been formally put forward;
- heard the Chair report on the state of play of the European Year of Skills announced by Commission President von der Leyen in her latest State of the Union Address, and decided to accept EMPL as lead committee on this file in the EP provided that: 1) the input by CULT is adequately taken on board by EMPL, that 2) CULT is adequately involved in the legislative procedure and the implementation of the Year, and that 3) granting EMPL a leading role on this file is not setting a precedent for future dossiers dealing with “skills”, for which CULT and EMPL are jointly competent;
- heard the Chair present the provisional calendar of CULT Committee meetings for 2023, endorsed that Calendar, and decided to avoid CULT Coordinators’ meetings on Mondays whenever possible;
- heard the Chair report on the presentation of the EU Youth Action plan in external relations by Commissioner Urpilainen in the DEVE Committee on 17 November 2022, 09:00-10:00, to which all CULT Members are invited;
- heard the Chair report on the Erasmus+ scrutiny meeting with

Commission representatives on 24 October 2022, and entrusted the Chair and the Erasmus+ Standing Rapporteur to communicate the main problems identified and requests made in that meeting to Commissioner Gabriel.

4. Compromise amendments, voting lists and voting procedures in CULT

AD: ND/MJP

Decisions:

- **The Coordinators fully endorsed the rules in force and the customary practice in the EP concerning compromise amendments, voting lists and voting procedures in general as recalled by the Chair, in particular:**
 1. **Amendments are regulated in Rule 181 of the EP's Rules of Procedure (RoP), which applies *mutatis mutandis* also for committees. Rule 181 leaves it up to the committee Chairs to decide on the admissibility of amendments. Henceforth, and in line with a recent CCC decision on this matter, a more rigid stance will be taken in this regard also in CULT, with amendments that do not clearly fall within the competence of CULT no longer being put to the vote in the future.**
 2. **Compromise amendments as a specific form of amendments are also regulated in Rule 181. This rule and common practice in the EP leave considerable leeway for Rapporteurs to suggest compromises. Whether compromises are deemed admissible is up to the Chair and ultimately the Members, who can object to suggested compromises. In such a case, a procedural vote in advance of the vote on the compromise takes place.**
 3. **Voting lists are first and foremost an auxiliary tool for committee Chairs to allow for a smooth voting procedure, and Chairs have the final say in how voting lists and actual committee votes are organised. In line with customary practice, all amendments on a given paragraph fall if a compromise on that paragraph secures a majority (unless something else has been explicitly agreed upon during the compromise-finding stage). Even if amendments are tabled as new paragraphs, it does not mean that such amendments are automatically voted separately. Depending on their content, even such amendments may fall if a particular compromise is adopted. Nevertheless, a Member is under no circumstances deprived of his/her democratic rights since compromises are by nature only proposals that the majority can always either adopt or reject.**
 4. **Deadlines are to be strictly observed, be it for the tabling of amendments, comments on compromise proposals and voting lists, etc. Everything received after such deadlines will not be taken into consideration, and the Secretariat is asked to apply an even more rigid stance in this regard in the future.**
- **The Coordinators agreed to encourage Rapporteurs of CULT reports and opinions to abstain from tabling compromises on paragraphs concerned by only one amendment, and to organise at least one meeting of Shadow Rapporteurs before the vote, irrespective of how controversial the respective dossier might be.**

5. European Year of Youth event on 5 December 2022

AD: SM

Decision:

- **The Coordinators endorsed the suggested experts and the draft agenda for the CULT Committee's event on 5 December 2022 at the occasion of the European Year of Youth.**
- **The Coordinators authorised the reimbursement of travel and accommodation costs for the experts participating in that meeting in person on an exceptional basis.**

6. Mission to Budapest, Hungary from 2-4 November 2022

AD: SM

Decisions:

- **The Coordinators endorsed the final draft programme and the final draft list of participants for the CULT mission to Budapest (Hungary), 2-4 November 2022.**
- **The Coordinators took note of the fact that Ms Livia Járóka (NI, Hungary) will temporarily join the delegation and attend the meeting of the delegation on 3 November 2022, from 12:30-14:30.**

7. CULT strategic priorities for the remainder of the parliamentary term: reports and PolDep research

AD: ND/MJP

Decisions:

- **The Coordinators decided to entrust the Chair to request authorisation for the CULT Committee to draft the following implementation reports:**
 - **The implementation of the current Erasmus+ Programme**
 - **The implementation of the current Creative Europe Programme**
 - **The implementation of the current European Solidarity Corps**
 - **The implementation of the current CERV Programme (for those elements falling under the CULT remit)**
- **The Coordinators heard the Chair report that while an own-initiative report on “The System of European Schools” is currently ongoing, which – once finished – will be followed by an own-initiative report on “European Historical Consciousness” as already decided by the CULT Coordinators, two new CULT own-initiative reports could be initiated in December 2022.**
- **The Coordinators endorsed the deadline of Friday, 25 November 2022, 12:00, for new own-initiative reports – both non-legislative and legislative – to be proposed by the political groups in written form, to be sent to the CULT Secretariat accompanied by a detailed motivation for the respective proposal.**
- **The Coordinators decided to request the Policy Department to continue providing, budgetary and personnel resources permitting, tailored high-quality support in the form of *concomitant expertise* to ongoing and forthcoming CULT reports, both legislative and non-legislative, including the above-mentioned implementation reports.**

8. Cultural Heritage Expert Group

Decision:

- **The Coordinators endorsed the deadline of Friday, 25 November 2022, 12:00, for submitting nominations for the vacant CULT observatory seat in the European Commission's Cultural Heritage Expert Group.**

9. Petition No 0020/2022 by Fernando Herrera de las Heras (Spanish) on the return to Greece of fragments of the Parthenon held by other Member States

Decisions:

- **The Coordinators decided to entrust the Secretariat to collect more information on this issue.**
- **The Coordinators decided to organise a dedicated session with the European Commission in the first quarter of 2023 on the issue of the return and restitution of cultural goods.**

- 10. Petition for opinion: Petition No 1060/2021 by María José González-Mayo Rodríguez-Irizabal (Spanish), on behalf of the Federación Nacional de Centros de Educación Infantil (National Federation of Preschools), on investment in public preschool education places in the Spanish Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan (EN)**

Decision:

- **The Coordinators entrusted the CULT Secretariat to compile information on this matter and, on that basis, the Chair to prepare a draft opinion on petition No 1060/2021, to be assessed by the Coordinators in one of their next meetings.**

11. Involvement of Switzerland in the Erasmus+ Programme

AD: DC

Decisions:

- **The Coordinators approved the draft oral question as proposed by the Chair.**
- **The Coordinators decided to submit the oral question together with a motion for a resolution, and entrusted the Chair to prepare a corresponding draft and initiate the necessary procedure at committee level for this motion for a resolution.**

12. Resolutions, petitions, miscellaneous reports and communications, letters, follow-up by the European Commission to the Parliament's positions

Decisions:

- **The Coordinators took note of the following resolutions, petitions, miscellaneous reports and communications received for information, letters sent by the Chair on behalf of CULT and letters received, and follow-ups by the European Commission to the Parliament's positions, deciding not to take any action or do a follow-up at this stage.**
