The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 51 of the Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to Article 61(a) and (b) of the EC Treaty,
- expressing serious concern at the human tragedy involving illegal immigrants in the Mediterranean,
- expressing its appreciation of the Council's intention to set up a European Border Management Agency,
- 1. Proposes the creation of a European multinational department to provide assistance and support to national police forces in combating illegal immigration;
- 2. Calls on the Council and the Commission to examine the possibility of a satellite system to intercept illegal immigrants arriving by sea;
- 3. Asks the Commission to examine the possibility of suspending economic relations with countries which refuse to cooperate, by signing agreements, in carrying out border controls and combating human trafficking;
- 4. Calls on the Commission to propose to the Council the introduction of a European system for the exchange of information on asylum, immigration and countries of origin;
- 5. Instructs its President to forward this declaration to the Commission and the Council.
