Written declaration on the third anniversary of the taking hostage of Ingrid Betancourt and Clara Rojas

The European Parliament,

- having regard to its resolution on Colombia of 14 March 2002
- having regard to Rule 116 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas Council Decision of 2 April 2004 implementing Article 2(3) of Council Regulation (EC) No 2580/2001 of 27 December 2001 on specific restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities with a view to combating terrorism, includes the Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia (FARC) on the list of these persons and entities.
- B. whereas 23 February 2005 marked the third anniversary of the kidnapping of Ingrid Betancourt and her associate Clara Rojas by FARC,
- C. whereas Niall Connolly, Martin McCauley and James Monaghan were condemned to 17 years' imprisonment for terrorist acts, including the fact that they trained FARC terrorists,
- 1. Completely rejects terrorism in all its forms and condemns those who support terrorist organisations in any part of the world;
- 2. Calls on all elected representatives to support the efforts of those who continue to run the campaign for the liberation of Ingrid Betancourt and Clara Rojas;
- 3. Regrets that certain Members have tried to organise a meeting at the European Parliament in connection with Niall Connolly, Martin McCauley and James Monaghan under the slogan 'Bring them home';
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this declaration, together with the names of the signatories, to the Council, the Commission and the Member States.
