Written declaration on the resurgence of Nazism in Germany

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 116 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas political parties having a neo-Nazi character are enjoying increasing support in Germany,
- B. whereas a German child and youth welfare office is forbidding divorced parents of non-German origin from speaking to their children in Polish,
- C. whereas on 11 May in the Saxon state parliament an NPD party member spoke of the need to introduce 'special trains', alluding to the transports of Jewish victims of Nazism to German concentration camps,
- D. whereas in Germany there are increasing numbers of neo-Nazi demonstrations and assaults prompted by nationalism and racism,
- 1. Condemns all manifestations of Nazism in the European Union and recalls the murderous role played by the German system of national socialism in recent European history;
- 2. Calls on the authorities of the Federal Republic of Germany to effectively combat the resurgence of Nazism in Germany;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this declaration, together with the names of the signatories, to the government and legislative bodies of the Federal Republic of Germany.
