Written declaration on the European Union action needed to support the European aeronautical industry

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 116 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. knowing that the weakness of the dollar vis-à-vis the euro is placing the European aeronautic industry in mortal danger,
- B. whereas the demands of EADS shareholders for dividends are holding back the human and material investment necessary to develop Airbus,
- C. whereas the A380 industrial accident originated with an EADS leadership which harkens to financiers rather than the expertise of its employees,
- D. whereas the Power 8 plan, without remedying the problems from which Airbus is suffering, weakens its human potential, which is the company's only real source of wealth.
- 1. Calls on the Commission, within the WTO, resolutely to defend the reimbursable advances system, so that the A350 and the NSR can benefit from this kind of funding;
- 2. Calls on the Commission and Council to create the conditions whereby Airbus can fund its programmes by means of very low-interest loans from the EIB, to which end, the latter would refinance itself not on the financial markets, but on the basis of the ECB printing money;
- 3. Calls for firm Council intervention at ECB level so as to bring to an end the 'strong euro' policy;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this declaration, together with the names of the signatories, to the parliaments and governments of the Member States and to the Council and Commission
