Written declaration on fire safer cigarettes

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 116 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas cigarettes are responsible for an estimated one third of fire deaths and most nonfatal injuries in most European countries, causing at least 1 000 deaths every year and at least EUR 13 million of property damage,
- B. whereas a significant proportion of the deaths, injuries and destruction of property could be prevented through the introduction of a fire safety standard for cigarettes,
- C. whereas a coordinated EU approach is required so that the same technical standards for fire safer cigarettes are used across the Union to ensure coherent and rapid implementation,
- D. whereas it is technologically and economically feasible for cigarettes to meet fire safety standards,
- 1. Calls on the Commission and Council to:
 - take the necessary steps so that a mandate for an EU fire safer cigarette standard is rapidly sent to the European Committee for Standardization (CEN);
 - ensure this mandate requires tobacco manufacturers only to produce and market fire safer cigarettes in the EU; tobacco manufacturers should use ASTM International E2187-02b;
- 2. Instructs its President to forward this declaration, together with the names of the signatories, to the Council and the Commission.
