## Written declaration on the partial demolition by the Turkish authorities of an Orthodox monastery on the island of Halki

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 116 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas in November 2007 officials from the Turkish forestry authorities partially demolished a 19<sup>th</sup>-century Orthodox monastery on the island of Halki,
- B. whereas, prior to demolition, the custodians of the monastery and their families were forced by Turkish officials to leave the monastery,
- C. whereas these actions are completely contrary to the freedom of religion, which is a significant element of the political Copenhagen criteria,
- 1. Condemns the actions of the Turkish forestry authority officials and considers that these are completely contrary to the political Copenhagen criteria;
- 2. Calls for the monastery to be restored to its original condition and for compensation to be paid, and an official apology offered, to the Orthodox community;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this declaration, together with the names of the signatories, to the Commission, the Council and the Turkish government.
