Written declaration on health literacy

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 116 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas there are currently an estimated 150 million patients throughout the EU and this will increase significantly due to the ageing population,
- B. whereas the positive role of 'health literacy' in terms of prevention, health promotion and patient-centred disease management is widely recognised,
- C. whereas the importance of health literacy is highlighted in the EU health strategy 'Together for Health',
- 1. Calls on the Commission and Council to acknowledge the following recommendations from EPF Conference 2008:
 - setting up an EU Health Literacy Network that involves all Member States and stakeholders.
 - wider distribution of quality health information to patients,
 - further training for health professionals to improve communication with patients,
 - further research on health literacy and its role in healthcare and health outcomes,
 - patients' meaningful involvement in health literacy policies and programmes;
- 2. Calls on the Commission and European Council to encourage their implementation through political commitment and resources;
- 3. Calls on the Commission and European Council to propose a Council recommendation on health literacy;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this declaration, together with the names of the signatories, to the Council and the Commission.
